Food will be provided, and all 2-Year ANNIVERSARY GOLD members will receive a ticket for one free drink!

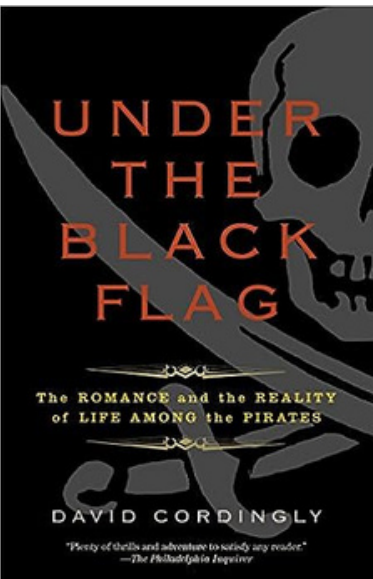


Book Club
