## **Foundation Information**

In support of our Foundation's focus on sight-related causes, last year we initiated several activities to support Lighthouse of SWFL and Southeastern Guide Dogs. This year, plans are bigger and better – continuing last year's activities and beginning some new ones to support these very important charities. The first new volunteer opportunity is **White Cane Day on Oct. 15.** See page 5.

I am continuing our work with Lighthouse of SWFL. Last year our group was very generous to Lily and she was overjoyed with our efforts! Thank you all so much! The iPad we purchased has helped her with continuity from school to home. This year, I would like to take advantage of our generosity toward gifts to benefit several individuals. The Lighthouse of SWFL wish list can be found at https://lighthouseswfl.org/donate/wish-list/

We would like to donate some of the items from their wish list.

- \$9.95 Talking Clock-This device allows a child to set an alarm or use a clock independently.
- \$10.95 Liquid Level Indicator-This device allows a child who is blind to pour liquids by themselves, thus encouraging them to be independent.
- \$13.80 20/20 pens (12 pack) These pens allow a child with low vision to write & be able to read what they wrote.
- \$75.00 **Rainbow II Color Reader**-This device allows a child with low vision or blindness to identify the color of their clothing, allowing them to better dress themselves.
- \$150.00 **Pen Friend** This device allows a child with low vision or blindness to identify objects in their environment and label them appropriately.
- \$402.79 Totally Tactile Communicator This device allows children who are nonverbal or still learning to talk the ability to communicate their wants or needs. This device allows children to have options of choices of what they want to do.

#### Foundation service hours are due to me by January 5.

If you volunteer in any capacity, please email a description of your activity and total hours spent between 7/1/19 and 12/31/19 to me at FortMyersDeltaGamma@gmail.com.

Examples of service hours include but aren't limited to:

- Vision screening
- Reading to individuals who are blind or visually impaired
- Recording books
- Organizing holiday parties at centers for those who are blind or visually impaired
- Promoting sight preservation education at community and campus health related events

Are you interested in the DG "**Joining Forces**" program? If so, please let me know of a local organization that serves blind or visually impaired military personnel.

The **Golden Anchor Program** seeks to support, enjoy the company of and bring joy to elder Delta Gammas and other senior citizens residing in health care facilities. Please let me know if you recommend a local facility where we can volunteer.

#### **Box Tops:**

Box tops are going digital and it is super easy!

- Traditional box tops are being phased out. However, both clipped physical box tops and digital submissions of receipts are options to earn money for schools and earn service hours. A maximum of two service hours per year may be received from participating in the Box Tops program.
- You may choose to support a local school for the blind or one of the Delta Gamma schools that participates in the Box Tops program:
  - Florida School for the Deaf and Blind, St. Augustine
  - o Blind Children's Center, Los Angeles
  - Children's Center for the Visually Impaired, Kansas City
  - o Foundation for Blind Children, Phoenix
- To participate using the digital submission, you need to either download the box tops mobile app or use the website BoxTops4Education.com, register and select one of the above schools. Receipts with eligible items <u>must be processed through the Box</u>
   Tops app or website within two weeks of purchase.
- Physical submission (Bring your Box Tops to any of our events)
  - O 30 box tops = one service hour
  - o 60 box tops = two service hours
- Digital submission:
  - \$3.00 earned = one service hour
  - \$6.00 earned = two service hours

You can get "A STATE OF VISION" Florida license plate to support Florida Agencies Serving the Blind, Florida ASB (such as Lighthouse of SW Florida). It has an attractive lighthouse on it!
