The Coat of Arms: The ZTA crest has a heraldic design enveloped with beauty, courage and high ideals. It is artistic in its simplicity, distinctive to the fraternity world and correct according to the rules governing heraldry. The detailed symbolism of the coat of arms is safely hidden away in the hearts and minds of all ZTA's. Five versions of the crest were

developed before the present day coat of arms was selected in 1926. Changes were made because of previous versions of the ZTA coat of arms did not satisfactorily represent the ideals of Zeta Tau Alpha or did not properly meet the rules governing heraldry.
