At the 3rd DG Convention in 1885, the cream-colored rose was chosen as the official flower of Delta Gamma. The rose is the apex of our official crest designed by Leota Woy, Phi-Colorado which was adopted by the 1909 Convention. The original living rose was the "Marechal Niel," which was more yellow than cream. It went out of favor and was forgotten. In 1976, a lighter cream rose was named "Delta Gamma" which also became obsolete.To commemorate our 150-year celebration, DG registered a new heartier rose with the American Rose Society named "Delta Gamma Heritage Rose." The name was selected by the sisterhood via social media vote in 2021. It is an antique-style garden rose that begins DG pink and turns cream rose as it blooms.

Members gathered in Costa Mesa for our kickoff event: French Garden Party!




