Feedback for 2020-2021

Thank you again to everyone who partook in the anonymous HAA survey about last year's term. We appreciate the feedback to help grow, improve, and strengthen the sisterhood. Great ideas and suggestions were shared, but also questions, so taking the opportunity to share answers that maybe can help pave the way for future decisions.

88.9% of the ladies that took the survey were dues-paying members for 2020-2021.

GATHERINGS

- The feedback included that everyone enjoyed the Gatherings online although some did admit to feeling a little 'burned out' of ZOOMing after a day of work that also included web calls.

- Sisters Who Sip: feedback was that people are thrilled and looking forward to finally meeting back in person.
- Being welcome: most felt welcomed but there is always room for improvement.

SUGGESTIONS

- Fundraiser: Even divide of 50%/50% response when asked if they donated.
- Alum-Collegiate Activities: While most in-person activities were canceled, replies shared that they would like to know the GO's more so it wouldn't feel off-putting to be present in the house. Additionally, those who didn't go to UofH would appreciate it if other collegiate groups were shared about.
- Social: 44.4% attended and enjoyed the Social Cooking Class
- Newsletter: lots of love and want to know more requests to include spotlights about what a position does to help clarify what dues go toward, a general breakdown of dues (I hear you page 2), a blurb to introduce new members, mailout to members who don't have email addresses and would love more announcements about achievements weddings, anniversaries, babies, etc.
- Social Media: loved seeing an increase in usage of Instagram and someone volunteered to help with content (hey you! It's anonymous you have to reach out to Samantha Kulbeth). Birthdays were brought up and if it was possible to wish a 'happy birthday' to all members. Evites are hard to track.
- Serving on the Board/Committee: time constraints and taking a break to let others lead the charge.

Overall, sisters were very impressed with how quickly executive and committee chairs changed their position to better accommade the pandemic world we survived through. Eveyone did their best and it was warmly received.
