2014-2015 Dues

This year our alumnae group had 61 local DGs join! Per Capita Dues to the Fraternity were paid by 164 local DGs. Our group's data base has over 1,600 members. As you know, after you have been with the Fraternity for 50 years you no longer have to pay Fraternity dues. (PCD to EO) Local dues are separate. Our Foundation This Year



Together, we are "Doing Good!"

Our members saved and turned in 769 Box Tops for Education which were then given to the local Blind Children's Learning Center. 567 Campbell's Labels for Education "points" were sent to Delta Gamma to be distributed to the schools owned and run by Delta Gamma across the United States. As many of you know, one of those schools is in Los Angeles!

At Founders Day, we raised \$187 for the Delta Gamma Foundation and \$1,684 for the benefit of the Blind Children's Learning Center.

Our speaker Wayne Heidle asked us to send \$100 to the Blind Children's Learning Center instead of giving him a speaker stipend. We did just that! We participated in the school's 5K Walk for Independence along with two other alumnae groups and the collegians from UCI's Delta Phi chapter. Together the DGs raised \$3,130 to support the school.
