SUITABILITY FOR THE DISABLED

The type of facilities available at Grey College and steps at most locations unfortunately make this symposium unsuitable for disabled people, including those in wheelchairs. The facilities might suit fully ambulant independent disabled people who can manage by themselves the many steps and long external and internal distances, even in bad weather: please enquire with DWM before booking. There are two single rooms en-suite suitable for disabled people, however no suitable toilet facilities exist elsewhere in the College, i.e.: dining room, conference centre, chapel and concert hall.
