Re: Text amendment to Zoning Bylaw 12800 to modify regulations regarding Alcohol Sales Uses

The Alberta Liquor Stores Association is advocating a Text Amendment to the Zoning Bylaw to make it easier for Alcohol Sales Uses that existed prior to April 17, 2007 to relocate and/or consolidate within their 500 m buffer area. The existing regulation in the Zoning Bylaw require Alcohol Sales Uses to be located at least 500 m away from each other. The 100 m separation requirement would continue to apply to new stores as well as stores that were approved after April 17, 2007.

This proposed Zoning Bylaw Text Amendment has a City Council Public Hearing target date of July 18, 2011. In order to ensure that your input is incorporated into the report for Council, **the Planning and Development Department is requesting responses no later than June 7, 2011.**
