

Key Features of Amplify Reading

Scope and Sequence

Amplify Reading is designed hand-in-hand with experts, drawing from the latest research. 



 - Browser: Chrome (latest stable version)
- **Mac Desktops and laptops**
 - Operating System: Mac OS 10.10+
 - Browser: Chrome and Safari (latest stable version)
- **Chromebooks**
 - Ideally touchscreen or with mouse
 - Browser: Chrome (latest stable version)
- **iPads**
 - iPad mini 2+, iPad 4+, iPad Air+, iPad Pro
 - Operating system: iOS 10.3+
 - Browser: Safari (latest stable version)
- **iPhones**
 - iPhone 6+
 - Operating System: iOS 10.3+
 - Browser: Safari (latest stable version)
- **Android Phones**
 - Samsung S8 and S9
 - Operating System: Android OS 7+

- **Network Requirements:**





Step 1: Click on the Amplify Reading: K-2 bookmark OR go to reading.amplify.com.




Step 2: Click "Enable Class Login".

Step 4: Type "LAUSD" as your SSO Domain.





Step 2: Students will be prompted to enter in a Class Code.




Step 3: Then, students will select their name from the class list to login to play!






Step 4: Click on the drop down menu to choose your class or group.



Step 5: Click on the **Class Setting** drop down to locate your **class code**. Write your class code onto the poster located on the next page.







Step 1: Go to lausd.mclasshome.com and sign in with your LAUSD email address.




Step 2: Tap on the **Amplify Reading Tile** to access your teacher dashboard from your mCLASS homepage.






Accessing the Student Experience:
