Password Security

Whereas Southern Connecticut State University exists for the primary purpose of furthering academic excellence;

And whereas the achievement of academic excellence, including the daily instruction of students and ongoing communication among all members of the university community, depends heavily on the efficient, uninterrupted functioning of SCSU's computer network;

And whereas SCSU's computer network requires multiple passwords for faculty, students, and staff;

And whereas passwords must be changed periodically to ensure security;

And whereas a change in passwords occurred, most recently, during new student orientation and at the beginning of the semester,

And whereas the change interrupted both network and individual computer access, caused widespread confusion among faculty and students, and seriously impeded instruction and communication at a critical time during the academic calendar;

Therefore, be it resolved that:

All password changes be implemented during times that are least intrusive to the academic calendar;

And be it further resolved that:

Administration allocate additional resources to support the faculty, students, and staff during those times.
