Prosecutors are prosecutors no matter what country you go to. It is like a stubborn person we all know who will never admit a mistake. Once a prosecutor charges someone – that is it! They do not care about truth, justice or even God. They will say anything and do anything just to win. Surely, human rights demand some sort of legal reform. Amanda would rot in jail for life if it had been a federal prosecutor. For you see, it is LIBERAL for a judge to ever rule in favor of a defendant. Amanda had a jury, and that was the difference. In the United States, it is always judges who decide the fate and such people are only former prosecutors that amounts to a clear conflict of interest.

The decision to indict **MUST** be taken away from these people. The nature of the job attracts those who would otherwise be criminals for they hurt others intentionally with the blessing of government. There is no difference in character between them and the accused. They accused Amanda of being a vile person who looks like an angel. What they did to Amanda and their family was the same evil character they accused her of having. It is time to human rights to stop these people. The dignity of the people **MUST** be respected or everything falls apart. This sort of corruption is everywhere in government.
