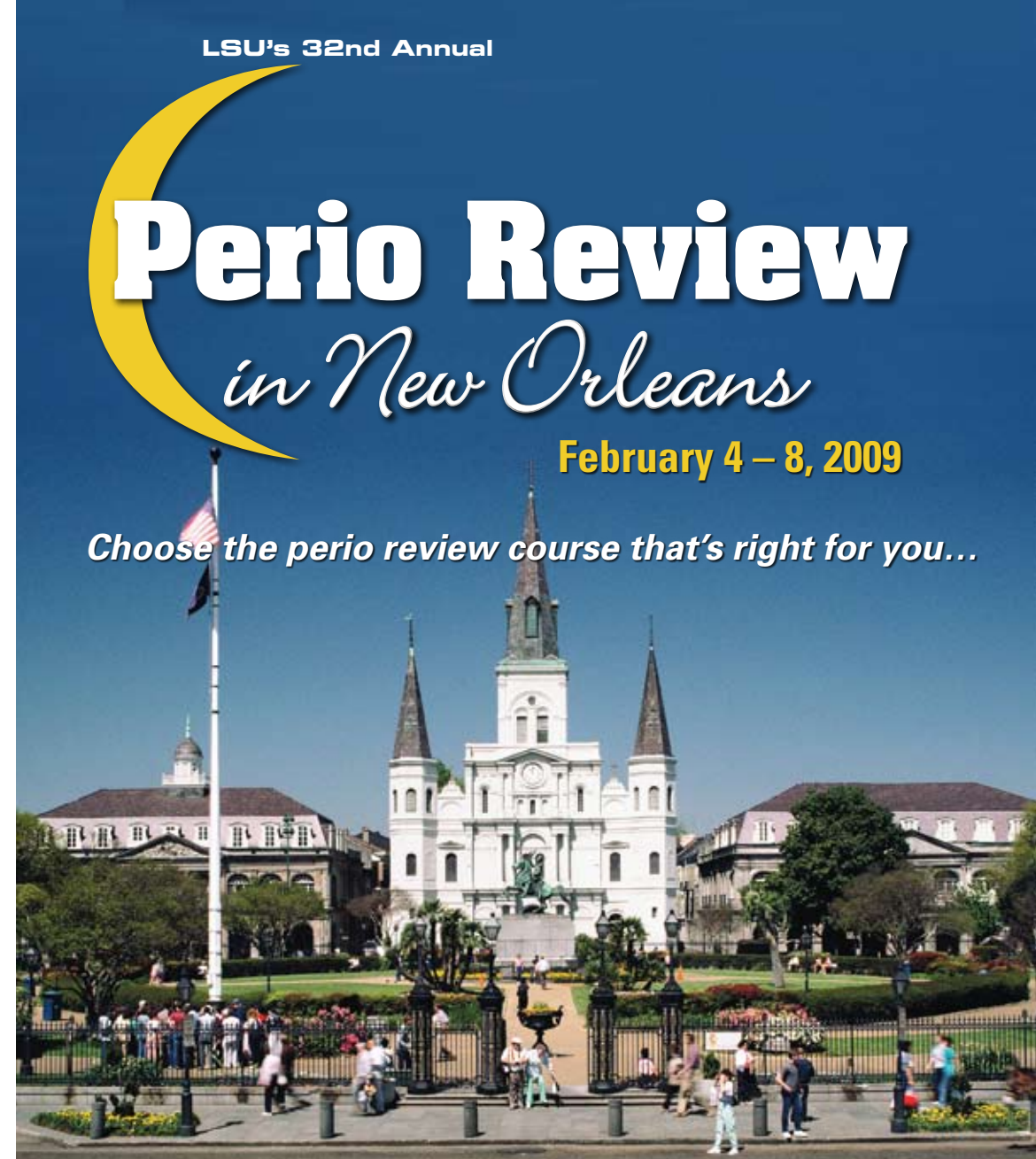
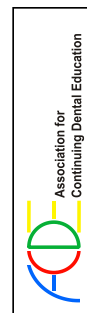

The course will be held at the LSU School of Dentistry. A central pick up location on Canal Street will transport participants to and from the Dental School each day except Sunday afternoon, the last day of the course.

## Objectives & Overview

Since the first LSU Perio Review was held thirty-two years ago, LSU Continuing Dental Education has continued to focus on two basic perio review objectives. The first objective is to help periodontists prepare to take the oral exam (Part II) for certification by the American Board of Periodontology. The second objective is to provide all practicing periodontists with a comprehensive, 3-day review and update.

Those preparing to take the oral exam for certification should register for the 5-day course. This course starts on Wednesday, February 4, 2009 and ends on Sunday, February 8, 2009. The first two days - Wednesday and Thursday - are two days of mock oral board exams, and the remaining 3 days - Friday, Saturday and Sunday - are a comprehensive review and update covering key perio topics. Periodontists who are not preparing to take the oral exam for certification, but feel they need a perio review and update, should register for the 3-day course. This course starts on Friday, February 6, 2009 and ends on Sunday, February 8, 2009.

The 3-day comprehensive review and update covers:

- ✓ Current concepts - particularly as they relate to management of patients with advanced periodontal disease.
- ✓ New developments and a general update in periodontics.
- ✓ Systemic influences on periodontal disease and patient management and periodontal medicine.
- ✓ Management of office emergencies and diagnosis of oral lesions.

*Each day begins at 8:00 a.m. and ends between 5:00 - 6:30 p.m.  
The course ends at 2:30 p.m. on Sunday, February 8, 2009.*

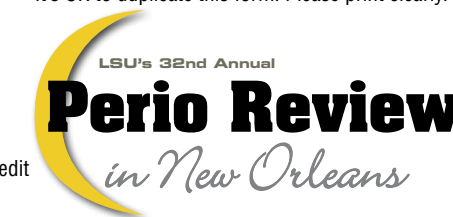
