**2. CFL Streaks:**

Several important streaks have dominated in the CFL in recent weeks and here are a number of them in detail:

- The **BC Lions** stretched their CFL-best record to 10-4 last week with a divisional win over Calgary and now lead the West by two games. After a 2-2 start, the Lions have gone 8-2 since then and last week secured a playoff berth for the **16th consecutive season**. The streak is the team's longest since they began play in 1954 and is tied for the third longest in league history. The Lions captured the season series with Calgary (8-6) in the 27-22 win but trail Saskatchewan (8-6) 2-1 with the fourth game to come.

- **Luca Congi** continued his strong comeback last week with yet another perfect field goal performance and has now upped his **consecutive field goal streak to 23** (last miss Aug 16/12 from 39 yds) and is tied with Dean Dorsey (Ottawa 1986-87) for the 5th longest streak in league history. Eight of his 23 successful FGs have come from 40+ yards and he has been perfect in 10 of the 12 games in which he has attempted an FG. Here are the all-time leaders: Paul McCallum 30 (2011), David Ridgway 28 (1993), Paul McCallum 24 (2009-10), Sean Whyte 24 (2011). **Four of the league's top six FG made streaks have come since 2009.**

- **Anthony Calvillo** threw one TD pass last week stretching his to 14 games. AC also went past Damon Allen (9,138) raising his now all-time record of pass attempts 9,147 and has 4,244 passing yards this season – a run of five straight seasons above 4,000.

- **Nik Lewis** caught 6 passes for 77 yards last week from Kevin Glenn to go over the 1,000 mark for the ninth consecutive year. That streak ties Milt Stegall and Geroy Simon for second longest all-time – Lewis has never had less than 1,013 yards in any season and has a reception in all 154 of his career CFL regular season games.

- One week ago **Fred Stamps** still needed 275 more to reach 1,000 receiving yards with 5 games to get there. Last week, Stamps set a 2012-CFL season-high with 204 yards vs Hamilton and pulled to within 71 yards of a fourth consecutive year at 1000+.

**4. All-Time Highest Single-Season Pass Efficiency Ratings:**

In league history, there have been only 17 previous times where a player has posted a single-season passer rating higher than 104.9 (min. 300 attempts), a figure that Hamilton's **Henry Burris** has reached in 2012 through 14 games. Among those 17 players, **no team in that season ever had a losing record**. The lowest winning pct. to date is the 9-9 mark by Edmonton in 2004 when Jason Maas posted a passer rating of 105.1. The most recent comparison to Burris' achievements in spite of a 5-9 Hamilton record in 2012 is Ricky Ray in 2007. Ray posted a 101.6 pass efficiency rating with Edmonton at 5-12-1 (.306).

**5. Week #16 Game Previews****Gm #65 – BC at Hamilton – Oct 12/12:****BC Lions:**

- **Playoffs Again:** The Lions clinched a playoff spot last week and are now up to 16 consecutive years in post-season play (1997-2012). BC has a two-game lead over Calgary and Saskatchewan but still needs at least 3 wins at this point to clinch the host spot in the 2012 West Final. Here is a breakdown of the previous 15 season finishes: 1st: 6, 2nd: NONE, 3rd: 6, 4th: 3. The Lions have not finished second since 1986 only twice in 58 prior seasons.

- **10 wins / 5 road wins:** The win over Calgary last week moved BC to 10-4 and a win total of 10+ for the 9th time in the last 11 seasons. This week BC will be looking for a fifth road win for 2012 and to clinch a .500 or better mark away from home for the ninth time in the last 10 years. No other club has had more than 5 years above .500 away from home in that 10-year span. Here is a comparison of BC's ability to win on the road since 2003 (9 seasons): BC 8 years at .500+, Cgy 4 years, Edm 2 years, Ham 1 year, Mtl 5 years, Ssk 2 years, Tor 4 years, Wpg 2 years.

- **Andrew Harris:** In league history, only **10 Canadian players** have ever reached 1,500 yards from scrimmage in a season including **Andrew Harris** in 2012 (1,544). He needs 119 yards to become the all-time single-season leader among Canadian players – he currently ranks #6 all-time, 14 yards behind fellow BC Lion Matt Clark.

- **Andrew Harris II:** In club history, **17 Lions players** have reached 1,000 rushing yards in a season including two Canadians: **Bob Swift** in 1964 (1,054), and **Sean Millington** in 2000 (1,010). **Martell Mallett** was the last BC Lions player to go over the mark – 1,240 in 2009. **Andrew Harris** (915) needs 85 yards to reach 1,000 and 140 to post a new record for a Canadian player.

**5. Week #16 Game Previews**

---

**Gm #65 – BC at Hamilton – Oct 12/12:****BC Lions: (Cont'd)**

- **Paul McCallum 2,685 points:** The Lions' kicker leads the CFL with 139 points and has gotten to within 15 of the 2,700 point mark for his career. He is 63 points behind the #4 spot held by Troy Westwood (2,748).
- **Wire-to-wire (almost):** Last week BC led after each quarter stopping a stretch where the club had not led after 7 of the previous 8 quarters (over two games). The BC touchdown in the first quarter last week was their first since Sep 8/12 vs Montreal.
- **Close Games of Late:** Over the last four weeks, the margin of victory in Lions' games has been 5, 6, 1 and 5 points for an average of just 4.3 points. BC is 6-3 in the nine games they have had that have been decided by 9 points or less in 2012.
- **Cashing on Turnovers:** Over the last 7 games the Lions have forced 10 turnovers but have not scored a touchdown in any drive following an opponent giveaway and just 6 points in total.
- **Sacks Allowed Leader:** The sack allowed to Calgary last week snapped a three-game run with zero by their opponents. The Lions lead the CFL with just 14 given up, 7 less than any other CFL club.
- **Rebounding QB: Travis Lulay** rebounded last week from his lowest rated game of 2012 (68.3 on Sep 27/12 at Ssk) to post his fifth game of the year above a 100.0 passer rating (114.2 vs Calgary on 23-of-33 for 268 yards, 2 TDs, 0 Ints). In the absence of Simon and Bruce, Lulay hit NINE different receivers in the win over Calgary.

**Hamilton Tiger-Cats:**

- **500+ points / scoring lead:** Despite a 5-9 record, Hamilton leads the CFL at 30.1 points per game on pace for 541. The 30.1 per game is their second-highest per game average in club history – **no team with a losing record has ever led the CFL in scoring**. They last reached 500 points in a season in 1999 when they had a club record 603.
  - **More on Congi's FG Streak:** The Ti-Cats kicker has not missed a FG attempt since a 39-yarder on Aug 16/12 at Winnipeg. In Congi's streak of 23 straight, 8 of them have come in windy Ivor Wynne Stadium where he is 14-of-15 for the season (93%) and 5-for-5 from 40+ yards. By comparison, **opponent kickers are just 11-for-18 (61%) at Ivor Wynne in 2012**. During Congi's streak his 23 made FGs have come from an average of 30.8 yards with 15 inside the 40 and 8 from 40+ yards.
  - **Cross-Overs:** The Ti-Cats loss to Edmonton combined with the Argos' loss and Winnipeg's win over Montreal threw the Eastern playoff race into a scramble yet again with four games left: Toronto 7-7, (Edmonton cross-over 6-8), Hamilton 5-9 and Winnipeg 4-10. The Blue Bombers play all three East Division clubs once more each and thus are still very much involved with four games to go. The last cross-over playoff team was BC in 2009 and since 2002 the West has gotten the last Eastern spot 5 times.
  - **Avon Cobourne / Henry Burris:** The Ti-Cats starting RB has played just 6 games but **leads the CFL at 94.0 rushing yards per game**. He has averaged 103 yards per game over the last five contests with 18 10+ yard runs, five of which have gone for 20 or more. **QB Henry Burris** has had almost as many rushing yards in the last two games (84) as he had in the previous seven (95). This week's game will feature the league's top two running QBs as Travis Lulay leads with 467 yards.
  - **Tight Coverage for CW:** The Ti-Cats leading receiver **Chris Williams** features six kick return TDs, but is also two yards short of 1,000. Close coverage has limited him to just 33 yards per game on 8 catches over the last three after averaging 82 per game in the first 11 contests. **Andy Fantuz** has picked up the slack with 8 catches for clutch first downs in the last three games.
  - **Single-season passing record: Henry Burris** ranks second in CFL passing yards this season with 4,120 and needs to average 303.5 per game to challenge Danny McManus' Ti-Cats record of 5,334 yards set in 1999.
  - **Turnovers:** The Ti-Cats are 3-0 this year when making less turnovers, 2-9 when making even or more (8-71 since 2006).
  - **Tailback Combo:** The **1,134 total rushing yards** recorded by the Ti-Cats duo of **Avon Cobourne** (564) and **Chevon Walker** (570) is challenging Calgary's Jon Cornish (1,188) and Saskatchewan Kory Sheets (1,035) for the league-lead. In terms of productivity from running back in Hamilton, they have played in the same game just twice with Walker getting just 6 carries in those two games (Cobourne starts) so the total is comparable to the two individual leaders.
  - **Armando Murillo:** Led the entire CFL in tackles last week with 9 and has 48 in his last 9 games, a pace that would match nearly 100 across a full season.
  - **Hitting 20/30 points Matters:** The Ti-Cats are 25-11 since 2006 when scoring 30+ points ... but when held under 20 points they are 1-43 over the last seven seasons.
  - **Second halves:** Hamilton has either led or been within 4 points at half-time in 11 of their 14 games this season, but has been outscored 276-205 in the final 30:00 of games. They have outscored an opponent in the 2nd half only three times in 2012.

1. GAME OVERVIEW & WRAP-UP FROM LAST WEEK

With a sixteenth consecutive playoff spot in hand, the Lions hit the road for their final game against an Eastern Division opponent, and with the West Division race still very much up in the air. First place in the West still requires at least three wins or opponent losses and Saskatchewan leads in the season series and is even closer than second place Calgary. The Lions beat the Stampeders last week holding on late and needing a Ryan Phillips interception with 2:40 to play and a knockdown with 0:38 left to stop Calgary drives. BC had led 27-13 to start the final quarter and behind a strong defence assumed a two-game lead in the West. Travis Lulay extended his club record streak to 25 games with a TD pass and Andrew Harris extended his CFL leading yards from scrimmage total to 1,544 yards, 60 ahead of Kory Sheets.


Hamilton has been a tough opponent for the Lions having swept last season's series and taken the Lions down to the wire in the first game 2012 in Week #2 at B.C. Place Stadium. The Lions won that game by just 39-36 to get to the 2-0 and then dropped the next two games. Since then they are 8-2 and play a Hamilton club that scores a lot of points and has allowed even more. The Lions may get Geroy Simon and Khalif Mitchell back from injury this week though Arland Bruce III may miss a second straight contest.

**Lions All-Time Quarterbacks:** Here is a look at the long list (55 of them) of BC starting quarterbacks since the team entered the WIFU in 1954. The Lions have had **40 regular starters at QB** in that span along with 15 others who started a game or two as injury replacements. Current starter **Travis Lulay** opened up in Weeks #4-6 of 2010 and again over the last six weeks of 2010 before posting an 11-7 mark as full-time pivot in 2011. He captured the 2011 CFL Most Outstanding Award along with 2011 Grey Cup MVP honours and has gone 10-4 as a starter in 2012.

## IT COULD HAPPEN IN 2012 ...

## Team marks and notables to watch out for in 2012

- 991 This week's game marks the 991st regular season game in club history. The Lions have won 477 of them including a 268-211-16 record at home.
- 16 With a playoff appearance in 2012, the Lions would extend their current streak to 16 straight years of post-season play.
- 10 In 10 of the last 11 seasons, the Lions have managed to outscore opponents and 2012 has started off in a positive way. Through 10 games the club has outscored their opponents by 270 to 181 and are averaging 18.1 points per game against.
- 8 With another spot in a Division Final in 2012, the club would extend their successful stretch to eight berths in the last nine years in the game that leads straight to the Grey Cup. BC has played in the Western Final six times and once in the Eastern Final in the last eight seasons.
- 8 General Manager Wally Buono will be looking for his eighth career Grey Cup championship heading into 2012. Wally earned two as a player with Montreal in 1974 and 1977 and another five as Head Coach including two with the Lions in 2006 and 2011.
- 5 The Lions will be looking to extend another streak of road success this year and post a mark better than .500 away from home. The club has hit the .500 mark in eight of the last nine years and has gone 3-2 away from home in 2012.
- 3 Wins in the West Division are always difficult due to the highly competitive rivalries and long history. The club went 8-2 in the West last year after three straight seasons below .500 at 4-6. Through Week #11, the Lions are 2-2 against Western teams with at least three more wins needed to reach .500.
- 2 BC has never won the Grey Cup in back-to-back years and have another chance in 2012 after last season's great recovery and run to the title.
- 1 Looking for number 13 – a first place finish would be the thirteenth in club history and the sixth in the last nine years.

## Player Milestones for 2012

- 1,000 With another 1,000-yard receiving season, **Geroy Simon** would extend his club record to 10 straight years. The streak would be the CFL's second-longest ever (Terry Vaughn leads with 11 in a row). Geroy has 467 yards in 9 games thus far in 2012. Over the last 8 games Geroy would have to average 67 yards per game to get there again.
- 390 **Andrew Harris** needs 390 rushing yards to reach the 1,000-yard mark for the first time in his career and is on pace for 1,098 in 2012.
- 41 **Adam Bighill** has 59 tackles after 10 games is on pace for 106 in 2012. He needs 41 more to reach 100 this year.
- 25+ The Lions currently employ the league's top four active interceptors in Korey Banks (34), Byron Parker (28), Ryan Phillips (31) and Dante Marsh (25). All four have 25 or more career interceptions and Marsh leads the way with two this season.
- 21 QB **Travis Lulay** has thrown at least one TD pass in 21 consecutive games. To reach the CFL's Top Two all-time best streaks on his own he needs to add one more game to the run and surpass Doug Flutie and Anthony Calvillo at 21 games in a row.
- 18 **Angus Reid** needs to play 18 games in the 2012 season to pass several Lions' greats and pull into 6th (with Jim Young) on the all-time BC Lions games played list. Heading into Week #12, Angus has logged 189 games in a BC uniform since 2001 and now sits at #8 all-time after passing Brent Johnson earlier this season.
- 6 **Arland Bruce** has 34 catches in the first 10 games and needs 6 more to reach 700 for his CFL career.
- 4 **Ryan Phillips** (31) needs 4 interceptions in 2012 to move into 4th place among all-time club leaders.
- 3 **Geroy Simon** (967) needs 3 receptions to move past Darren Flutie who sits in 3rd place (972) after the 2011 season. A season with 82 receptions would match the all-time league leader Ben Cahoon's 1,017. Geroy Simon needs to play 17 games in the 2012 season to reach 200 for his BC career.
- 3 **Keron Williams** needs 3 more sacks to reach double figures in 2012 and leads the CFL after eight games with 7.
- 1 **Geroy Simon's** next touchdown will be the 100th of his CFL career. He has 98 receiving TDs and one rushing.
