Other than two significant interruptions to support Canadian war-time efforts, the Canadian Football League and its direct predecessor leagues (the IRFU in the East and the WIFU in the West) have been in operation continuously since 1907. Today's CFL East Division has provided over 100 years of football in Canada, while the West Division has been in operation since 1936. Next season the CFL re-starts in Ottawa with the *Redblacks*, the first team to operate in Ottawa since the Renegades from 2002-2005. The CFL season opener in Winnipeg will be the league's 5,171st regular season game since 1907.

Game #9:

- **Winnipeg:** Have won 2 of their last 3 season openers but dropped last year's as part of a tough post-Grey Cup opening run of four straight losses on the road to go 0-4 overall (due to stadium construction). With their brand new Investors' Group Field now in place, the Bombers will play 3 of their first 5 games at home in 2013.
- **Montreal:** Since 2008, the Als are one of only two teams to have won at least 10 games per season (a league-best .656 mark at 59-31). They have won 10 or more games in all but two years since re-joining the CFL in 1996. In 17 season openers since 1996, the Als have been an amazing 13-4 in opening week games (but two of those defeats came recently in 2010 and 2012).

Game #10:

- **Hamilton:** Has not won their first game of any season since 2004, a streak of 8 consecutive opening week defeats. They last opened against Montreal in 2008 (losing 33-10 at home).
- **Toronto:** Since 2004 the defending Grey Cup champions have won their next season's opening game just 4 times in 9 games, however the Lions in 2012 and Alouettes in 2011 won their season openers. Toronto will look to make that three times in a row. The Argos have **lost each of their last two season openers after Grey Cup wins** (to start 2005 and 1998).

Game #11:

- **Calgary:** Grey Cup appearances and season openers seem to correlate for the Stampeders. Since 1991 after a 20-year drought, Calgary has made it to the Grey Cup 8 times – and they won their season opener in 7 of those 8 seasons (only loss: 2001). In the other 14 season openers since 1991, they have split evenly at 7-7.
- **BC:** The Lions have won only 2 of their last 5 season openers and over the first half of each of the last 5 years have posted a record of only 19-26 overall (.422). They have bounced back each time with a better second half record however going 32-13 (.711) after the halfway mark since 2008. Last year BC started off at 2-2 and finished with an 11-3 run to finish first in the West.

Game #12:

- **Saskatchewan:** Has had the most success in season openers in recent years having won 5 of 6 since 2007 (losing only in 2011 at home to Edmonton). In the last 12 years, the Riders are 9-3 in season openers.
- **Edmonton:** Is the only CFL club to have won their season opener in each of the last two years. Over the last four years, the opener for the Eskimos has matched their season success. They won their first game in 2009, 2011 and 2012 and made the playoffs; in 2010 they dropped their season opener and finished out of post-season play at 7-11.

2. CFL Head Coaching Tenures:

The combined 11 years of head coaching experience (John Hufnagel 5 years, and Kavis Reed with 2 years are the only ones with more than one previous season) **matches 2012 with the smallest total in CFL history** excluding the post-War start up years of 1946-48. Here is a run-down of the cumulative coaching years starting several recent seasons: **2013** (11 years), **2012** (11 years), **2011** (34), **2010** (31), **2009** (23), **2008** (25), **2007** (37), **2006** (56). **John Hufnagel's 90 regular season games as head coach** is not much less than the combined 118 games of experience held by the other seven CFL head coaches.

There will be three coaches opening a season with their club for the first time: **Kent Austin** (Hamilton), **Tim Burke** (Winnipeg, took over midway in 2012), and **Dan Hawkins** (Montreal). **Mike Benevides** matched the CFL record last season for first-year head coaches with 13 wins and first in the West Division, while Toronto's **Scott Milanovich** took his team to a Grey Cup title in his debut season. That feat matched **Kent Austin** in Saskatchewan in 2007, and he is back in the CFL in 2013 with the Tiger-Cats.

Roster Overviews:

CFL Overall:

- The most noticeable aspect is that there was a 45% turnover from 2011 Week #1 to 2012 Week #1 rosters and that has decreased this year; in 2013 that roster turnover dropped to just 40% (players remaining on the same club). So fully 60% of club Week #1 rosters in 2013 comprise players that were there in 2012. For the CFL itself among all players in 2013, 70% remain in the league on some roster however to start 2013 from those that were there in 2012's Week #1.
- The clubs return 7 of the 8 starting QBs this year with only Edmonton to have a new starter in 2013.
- The clubs have included just 78 rookies on their 2013 Week #1 rosters compared to 104 in 2012. However, the total number of players with either none or just one previous season remains constant at 180+ (42% of the league).
- The average number of prior CFL seasons is up to 3.0 years per man compared to 2.8 (about 7% higher). In terms of total prior games played, this year's rosters bring about 10% more experience than in 2012.
- **BC:** The Lions at 4.0 years player remain the most experienced team in the league with almost a full year per man more than the second-highest average. BC has only 4 rookies on their roster and 36 of their 48 players have played 2+ CFL seasons.
- **Calgary:** Has as balanced a roster as any club with 18 players in either their first or second season but 25 individuals with at least four previous CFL years. They included just 6 rookies on their Week #1 roster and have 13 on the IL to start the year. They rank #4 in player experience at 3.2 years per man.
- **Edmonton:** Has a young roster averaging just 2.5 years per man and only 15 players with 4 or more previous seasons. Their roster has played a combined 1,833 games heading into 2013, more than 400 less than the CFL average.
- **Hamilton:** The Ti-Cats have a stunning 37 players in either their first or second CFL season – 61% of their 61-man roster. They average just 2.2 years per player (lowest in the CFL) but this young group is supported by 7 veterans with at least 7 previous CFL seasons. This is the second straight year they have begun with at least 18 rookies on their roster (20 in 2013).
- **Montreal:** Has the second-most experienced team in the league but that is affected by the very long careers of four key veterans (Calvillo, Flory, Bruce and Richardson). They have a league-high 13 players with 6+ years in the league but noticeably they also have 11 rookies on their roster for 2013 which is a significant turnover from 2012.
- **Saskatchewan:** Has clearly added the most experience in 2013 at 3.5 years per man compared to just 2.3 heading into 2012. Their roster in 2013 has played over 1,000 more CFL games than the 2012 opening day roster and features 36 players with at least two previous CFL campaigns.
- **Toronto:** Coming off their Grey Cup win, the Argos actually got much younger dropping from 3.3 previous seasons per man (2012) to just 2.7 in 2013. They have 16 first-year players or 1 in 3 with 50% of their players having one year or less under their belt.
- **Winnipeg:** Similar to 2012, the Bombers remain a club gaining experience off a young base. They are now fully 0.5 years per man more experienced than 2012 (2.5 vs. 2.0) with only 4 rookies, but are still under the league average of 2.8 years. Of their 51 roster players heading into 2013, 41 (80%) have played 3 years or less and they have the fewest 4+ year vets in the CFL with 10.

3. CFL Roster Analysis Part 2 - How Canadian Players Are Acquired:

Of the 432 players holding down roster spots as of June 23, 2013, 199 of them are classified as **non-imports** making up the Canadian contingent across the CFL. Here is an analysis of how those players joined the league initially:

- **Drafted vs Free Agent Signings:** Of the 199 Canadians on CFL rosters, 156 or **78%** of the total were selected in the annual CFL Draft. Of the 156 drafted players active today, **48 were 1st round selections**. The remaining rounds of the Draft have provided: **2nd Rd:** 35, **3rd Rd:** 25, **4th Rd:** 21, **5th Rd:** 17, **6th/7th Rd:** 10. Most teams have between 4 and 6 first rounders on their team at this time but Calgary stands above all other clubs with 11! There are currently 108 Canadians in the league that were selected somewhere in the first three rounds in their Draft year.
 - **CIS Schools vs the NCAA:** Of the 199 Canadians on CFL rosters, 136 or **68%** of the total played at CIS schools across Canada prior to coming into the league. A total of 7 entered the CFL from Canadian Junior Football ranks with the remaining 56 players completing their amateur days at NCAA schools or outside the country.
 - **By Draft Year:** Of the 60 players chosen in the 2013 CFL Draft, 14 made it onto their club's 46-man roster or Injured List to start the season. The most productive CFL Draft as of today is the 2010 class who have 27 of the 47 players chosen that year still on club rosters. From 2012 there are 22 players and another 21 from the 2011 Draft.
 - **By CIS School:** The University of Calgary holds top spot with 14 of their players currently on CFL rosters. The rest of the Top six is as follows: U of Saskatchewan 12, Laval 11, St. Mary's 11, Bishop's 7, and Western 7.

4. CFL Quarterback Experience Heading Into 2013:

If this is the age of record setting field goal success, it is even more that of the CFL quarterback. Of the league's all-time Top 6 leading passers, three are still starters playing at or near the top of their careers. All-time leader **Anthony Calvillo** will be making his 271st career start in the opener (his 20th year) and carries a 165-105 W-L record (155-75 with Montreal in 14 seasons). He needs just 1,506 yards to reach 80,000 and ranks #4 all-time in CFL regular season games played with 322. This will be the 14th straight season he has been his team's QB starter in Week #1.

After a 2012 season of 43 TD passes to set a new career high mark, Hamilton's **Henry Burris** sits at #5 all-time with 46,602 yards. He has started 168 CFL regular season games for a 90-75-3 WL record heading into his 15th season. He has thrown at least 20 TD passes in each of the last 9 seasons. Toronto's **Ricky Ray** captured his third Grey Cup ring last year and ranks #6 all-time with 44,590 passing yards. His 67.0% career completion % ranks #2 all-time behind Dave Dickenson and the opening week of 2013 will see him make his 163rd career start (86-75-1).

At #11 all-time is Calgary's **Kevin Glenn** who has 36,708 yards in his career, 2,333 yards out of the all-time Top 10. Saskatchewan's **Darian Durant** has a career record as a starter of 36-34-1 and is making career start #72 this week. He already sits in 33rd all-time in passing yards with 18,557 and has made two Grey Cup starts. BC's **Travis Lulay** has started 43 games in his CFL career for a 27-16 mark (.628) and has both a league's Most Outstanding Player and Grey CUP MVP Award to his credit (from 2011). He posted a streak of 26 consecutive games with at least one TD pass (ended in 2012). **The above six players topped the CFL in pass efficiency in 2012.**

Winnipeg features **Buck Pierce** whose career has been plagued in recent years by injuries which are a by-product of how hard he plays. Buck has 62 career starts and a solid record of 34-27-1 with BC and the Blue Bombers. His 14,113 career passing yards rank #47 all-time. Edmonton will likely be starting **Mike Reilly** to begin 2013 and he was key free agent signing in the off-season but has just two career starts (1-1). Reilly is backed up by Kerry Joseph who ranks #16 all-time at 27,244 yards.

- **Scoring:** League-wide scoring was up by 3% last season to 51.8 ppg led by a 15% increase in TD passes (228 up from 199 in 2011). Net offence was also up by 16 yards per game (2.2%). The average margin of victory in the CFL was 12.0 ppg.
- **Turnovers:** The biggest change over the last two seasons has been a 19% drop in the number of turnovers per game. In 2012, there were just 4.1 giveaways per game – **an all-time low for any season in CFL history**. The league's interception % dropped to just 2.9 per 100 attempts, nearly two interceptions lower than the average across league history of 4.8 per game.
- **A Passing League:** In 2012, teams rushed only 18.9 times per game on average – the second-lowest total in CFL history (1993 was 17.6). The league-wide pass efficiency rating of 93.5 ranked #1 all-time, only the second year ever it has been 90+. The eight teams rushed for 16,904 yards in 2010, and only 15,046 in 2012 - a drop of almost 2,000 yards.
- **A Golden Age for FG kickers:** Over the last two seasons, CFL field goal kickers have made 81.6% of their attempts. Prior to 2011, the league average since 1954 was just 66%, and as recently as 2005 it was just 71%.
- **Kick returners:** In 2012 brought back 14 for TDs, up by 6 from 2011 but not enough to match the 19 from the 2010 season. There were NO kickoff return TDs in 2012, the first time since 2001 that none occurred.
- **Comebacks:** In 72 regular season games in 2012, 36 wins were by teams coming from behind. The largest comeback was by Hamilton who trailed Saskatchewan by 19 before winning 35-34. A total of 40 of 72 games were decided in the final 3:00.

6. Other CFL Milestones & Notes:**Upcoming Milestones:**

- **Games Played:** **Chris Thompson** (EDM) and **Anton McKenzie** (BC) should reach 100 games this week if they dress for their clubs while **Dwight Anderson** (SSK) is just two away from the century mark. **Ryan Phillips'** active consecutive games played streak for BC is the longest in the CFL at 144 straight. **Sean Whyte** (MTL) will be playing in his 50th career game in Week #1. **Scott Flory** (MTL) has played 238 career regular season games and will move out of a tie with three others to stand #28 all-time.
- **Seasons Played:** **Anthony Calvillo** (MTL) will become just the seventh player all-time to play in at least 20 different CFL seasons and he trails only: Lui Passaglia 25, Bob Cameron and Damon Allen 23, Eddie Emerson 22, Hank Ilesic and **Paul McCallum** 20. McCallum can move up to #5 alone if he plays this week.
- **Receiving Leaders:** Three of the CFL's all-time leading receivers are active for 2013 (**Geroy Simon** #1, **Arland Bruce III** #12 at 10,774 yards, and **Nik Lewis** #13 at 10,473 yards). With 64 yards Bruce can pass Tom Scott (10,837) for the #11 spot. Other active players in the Top 50 are: **Jamel Richardson** at #39 (7,877) and **Terrence Edwards** (WPG) at #45 with 7,088. Lewis' consecutive games streak with at least one catch stands at 157 games.

WEEK #1 · JUNE 27-29 · CFL NOTES & TRENDS**7. Other CFL Milestones & Notes:**

- **Rushing Leaders:** With most of the league's all-time rushing leaders now retired, and the transition from early rushing precedence to the "passing game", little impact will be made this year. The Top 3 active rushers are all quarterbacks: **Henry Burris** (HAM) at #45 with 4,735 yards, **Kerry Joseph** #53 (4,470) and **Anthony Calvillo** #73 (3,662). The leading active rusher among running backs is **Jon Cornish** (CGY) with 3,327 yards at #84 all-time.
- **Geroy Simon (SSK):** Needs 11 receptions to become the third player to reach 1,000 and with 15,787 career yards is 213 short of becoming the first to reach 16,000. His consecutive streak of at least one catch has reached 173 games starting 2013.
- **Scoring Leaders:** **Paul McCallum** (BC) needs 16 points to move past Troy Westwood (2,748) into the #4 spot all-time. **Luca Congi** (HAM) sits in #23 with 928 and needs 24 points to surpass Dean Dorsey (951).

Historical Notes:

- **CFL History:** This week begins the league's 56th consecutive season since the amalgamation of the old IRFU (Big Four) in the East and the WIFU in the West in 1958 under the new **CFL** banner. Those two leagues have been in operation since 1907 and 1936 respectively and accounting for wartime efforts, the 2013 CFL season is Year #101 dating back to Eastern foundations.
 - **Investors Group Field in Winnipeg:** The Blue Bombers move into their new facility after spending 17 years (14 seasons accounting for wartime interruption) at Osborne Stadium (1936-1952: 69 GP, 44-24-1) and 60 years at Winnipeg-Canad Inns Stadium (1953-2012: 507 GP, 314-189-4). This will be **Season #75** for the Bombers in WIFU-CFL play since 1936.
 - **Starters Turnover from 2012:** Each week, 192 players are indicated by their clubs as "starters" though the Canadian game is somewhat fluid with varying formations. Of the 192 that started in Week #1 of 2012, **only 126 (65.6%) remain with their teams to start the 2013 season**. Calgary leads with 18 of their 2012 Week #1 starters still on their roster, Saskatchewan is at the other end with fully 12 or half the group of 24 players no longer with the Riders one year on. The rest are: Winnipeg 17, BC 17, Montreal 16, Edmonton 16, Toronto 15, Hamilton 15.
 - **Few All-Stars on the Move:** Among the 2012 CFL All-Star Team's 27 players, 25 of them remain with their clubs to start the 2013 campaign. Only Chris Williams (suspended), Armond Armstead (New England NFL) are not with their 2012 team. Since turnover among players year-to-year averages around 45%, CFL stars seem to stay where they have been leaders. Of the 52 Division All-Stars, only six have moved on and none at all from the 27 West Division players!
 - **Two in a row:** The Argos will be trying to make it two Grey Cup wins in a row this season and match Montreal's feat in 2009-2010. They are the only other club to repeat since 1982 and that was the Argos themselves in 1996-97.
 - **Playoff/10+ win runs:** Montreal (17 years), BC (16 years), and Calgary (8 years) carry significant playoff appearance streaks into the 2013 season. BC has been part of a Division Final in 8 of the last 9 years, while both Calgary and Montreal have been in 4 of the last 5 and each carries a 5-year active streak of at least 10 wins per season.
 - **Turnover Ratio Gap:** One critical element in deciding the outcome of games is of course turnovers. The 2012 season is really notable however in that the **gap** between the top ratio (Toronto at just +10), and the bottom ratio (Winnipeg at -17) was so small (**27**). This gap is the smallest between top and bottom in league history and has shrunk steadily since 2009. Recent years: 2011 - **33** (+16 to -17), 2010 - **41** (+18 to -23), 2009 - **60** (+32 to -28), 2008 - **35** (+20 to -15).
 - **Biggest Gains in 2012:** Both Toronto and Saskatchewan led the way with 3 more wins in 2012 than they had in 2011. Hamilton dropped from 8 to 6 wins but among their 12 losses, FIVE came by margins of 4 points or less.
 - **Home vs Away:** In 2012, only one club was able to win away from home in Week #1 (Saskatchewan over Hamilton) and in fact only one visitor won in any of the first 14 games. That leveled off a little eventually but 45 of 72 games were won by home teams. That 62.5% mark was the highest since 2003 and higher than the historical average of 58%.
 - **Margins of 0-4 Pts:** In 72 games last year, 21 were decided by 4 points or less compared to just 15 in 2011.
 - **2012 Leaders:** If you include Chris Williams of Hamilton (and he remains on their roster but suspended), each of the Top 17 receivers, 8 of the top 9 rushers, and each of the top 7 scorers remain with their teams in 2013 (Avon Cobourne is the exception).
 - **Longest current win streaks:** The Stampeders have the longest current regular season winning streak at 4 games. Toronto won their last two games plus all three in the post-season to stretch their overall run to 5 straight victories. Winnipeg finished up 2012 stronger with a 4-6 mark under Coach Tim Burke and alternated wins and losses over the final seven weeks.

1. GAME OVERVIEW

The Southern Ontario rivals will begin the CFL season against one another for the first time since 2009. The Argos marched into Hamilton's Ivor Wynne Stadium on July 1, 2009 and won the game 30-17.

BARN BURNER IN THE WORKS: Although the Double Blue may have finished the 2012 campaign 3-1 against the Tiger-Cats, the aggregate point differential was just +11 in favour of the Argos. There were at least 60 points combined between the two squads in each of those four games and the highest scoring affair was a combined total of 83 points (Nov.1: 43-40 TOR).

FAMILIAR FACES, DIFFERENT PLACES: This game will mark the first time former Argos Defensive Backs Coach and current Ticats Defensive Coordinator, **Orlando Steinauer** will face his old mates. **DB Evan McCollough**, who was the Argos' outstanding rookie in 2011, signed with Hamilton during the 2013 off-season and will play his first game not in an Argos uniform. Former Tiger-Cats **LB Jonathan Hood**, now a member of the Double Blue, stands to make his Argos debut.

LAST TIME THE ARGOS AND TIGER-CATS MET (2012)

- QB's Zach Collaros and Trevor Harris combined to go 14 of 25 for 178 yards and 1 TD.
- WR Dontrelle Inman led all receivers for 7 receptions, 128 yards and 1 TD.
- SB/KR Chad Owens passed Argos legend Michael "Pinball" Clemons in the record books for all-purpose yards in a season (3,840).
- K Swayze Waters kicked the game winning field goal with no time on the clock from 51 yards out.
- Chad Owens attempted and completed his only pass of the season on a 49-yard bomb to WR Spencer Watt.

"THE CHAD'S"

The Argos finished 4-1 in games when **SB/KR Chad Owens** and **RB Chad Kackert** had at least 50 yards receiving and 50 rushing, respectively, in the same game during the 2012 season.

THREE PLAYERS TO WATCH**OFFENCE**

SB/KR Chad Owens showcased why he was named the 2012 CFL Most Outstanding Player on multiple occasions against Hamilton last year. In the four games against Hamilton in 2012, Owens finished with 24 receptions for 319 yards and 1 touchdown, 19 kick returns for 453 yards, and 16 punt returns for 190 yards. His combined yards total was 962.

DEFENCE

CB Pat Watkins finished the 2012 season with 14 tackles and 2 interceptions against Hamilton. In the Labour Day rematch at Rogers Centre on September 8, Watkins picked off a Henry Burris pass and took it 27 yards to pay dirt for his only CFL touchdown.

SPECIAL TEAMS

K Swayze Waters connected on 80% of his field goal attempts against Hamilton last year (8/10). His longest field goal of the season came in the regular season finale against Hamilton, winning the game for Toronto on a 51-yard kick. With that, he officially eliminated the Tiger-Cats from the 2012 Grey Cup Playoffs.

THE RETURN: To close 2012, Kent Austin was named the Vice-President of Football Operations, General Manager and Head Coach of the Ticats. Friday night's matchup against Toronto marks Kent Austin's return to the CFL as a head coach. The last time Austin put on the headset in the CFL was on November 25, 2007, when he led the Saskatchewan Roughriders to the 95th Grey Cup in Toronto. As a head coach, Austin heads into Toronto posting a 2-0 record in the Rogers Centre with one of those wins coming against Toronto.

The restoration of the historic rivalry between the Ticats and Argos also marks the return of defensive coordinator **Orlando Steinauer** and DB **Evan McCollough** to the stadium that they previously called home for 10 (7 as a player, 3 as a coach) and three seasons, respectively; Toronto's Rogers Centre. Defensive backs coach **James Stanley** also spent the 2012 season with the Double Blue as the linebacker's coach.

BURRIS' BIG YEAR: In 2012, QB **Henry Burris** set the Ticats single-season record and career-highs in passing yards (5,367), completions (391) and passing touchdowns (43). Burris went 78 of 142 passing for a total of 1,231 yards and 11 touchdowns in the Ticats four meetings with the Argonauts. His best performance in the 2012 season series came on November 1, when he threw for 497 yards and four touchdowns on 37 of 55 passing, setting the Ticats single game record for completions.

RIVALRY RENEWED: Dating back to 1950, the Tiger-Cats are 123-90-2 in 215 games vs. the Toronto Argonauts. Since 1950, the Ticats have opened the season against the Argos on 11 previous occasions, sporting a 5-6 record in those contests.

PRE-SEASON RECAP

- The Tiger-Cats finished the pre-season **2-0** for the first time since 2009.
- The Tiger-Cats **defence** forced 12 turnovers, nine of them were interceptions.
- **Henry Burris** went 13 of 18 passing for 198 yards and two touchdowns in one half of play.
- **Greg Ellingson** had four receptions for 129 yards and a touchdown.
- **Lindsey Lamar** compiled a total for 435 combined yards (24 rushing/66 receiving/345 return yards) and two TDs.
- **Ricardo Colclough** registered nine defensive tackles and an interception.

THE LAST TIME THE TIGER-CATS AND ARGOS MET (2012)

- The Tiger-Cats lost the turnover battle **4-0** and the game **43-40**.
- **Henry Burris** completed 37 of 55 attempts for 497 yards and four touchdowns.
- **Andy Fantuz** led the team in reception with 10 catches for 109 yards .
- **Markeith Knowlton** led the team in defensive tackles with six.

RECORDS WITHIN REACH

After passing Doug Flutie and Matt Dunigan on the all-time list for passing yards and completions in 2012, Ticats QB **Henry Burris** currently sits at fifth all-time in passing, and sixth in pass competitions and touchdown passes. Burris needs six touchdowns to surpass Matt Dunigan for fifth on the CFL's all-time list.

- In 19 previous starts against Toronto, **Henry Burris** has averaged 257.6 passing yards per game.
- In four seasons with the Ticats, veteran linebacker **Jamall Johnson** has compiled 50 defensive tackles in 11 appearances against the Toronto Argonauts. Johnson has had 5+ defensive tackles in five of those games with his last 5+-tackle performance coming in last year's Labour Day Classic, when he had seven tackles.
- Ticats defensive back **Evan McCollough** has had five games where he posted 5+ defensive tackles at the Rogers Centre over his three-year career.
