**WEEK #14 · SEPTEMBER 27-29 · CFL NOTES & TRENDS****1. CFL Game Preview #58 · Calgary (9-3) at Hamilton (6-6)**

**Matchup:** The second game of CFL Week #14 features the second meeting in three weeks between Hamilton and Calgary and the home half for the Ti-Cats. **Calgary** trailed after each quarter at McMahon Stadium but rallied with a 10-0 final 15:00 to win 26-22. The win was keyed by an 8-play, 85-yards in 2:05 that culminated in a TD with 1:18 left. They have clinched a playoff spot but lead BC and Saskatchewan by a single win and with three games left against them. **Hamilton** sits in second at 6-6 having already reached last year's win total (6-12) and two games ahead of their 4-8 mark in 2012. They are two wins behind Toronto with a back-to-set with the Argos looming after this week. Hamilton has not finished first since 1998.

**Calgary vs Hamilton All-Time:** These two teams have played 84 times before with Calgary holding a wide edge at 54 wins to 30. The Stamps have won the last 3 meetings and 7 of the last 8. The Ti-Cats have built at least 7-point lead in each of the last five.

**Division-Heavy Schedules:** Calgary has completed 6 of their 8 games versus Eastern opponents and face Hamilton and Winnipeg in the next two weeks to wrap that up. The final four weeks of the 2013 CFL schedule are entirely Divisional games. Hamilton is just 2-5 against Western clubs while Calgary has gone 5-1 versus the East, their sixth straight year at .500 or better.

**Starting QBs:** **Calgary** has had three different QB starters in 2013 with **Kevin Glenn** at 5-2 leading the way. He returned after missing two games last week but Calgary lost to Toronto after leading by as many as 10 points. Each QB has led the team to a win – **the last time Calgary had three winning QBs in one season was 2005**. Glenn is 12-5 vs Hamilton as a starter, the second highest number of wins against any opponent and easily the best % at .706. Henry Burris has yet to win for Hamilton against his former team going 0-3 but two weeks ago posted his 13th career 400+ yard game vs Calgary. All-time Burris has a record of 96-81-3 in 180 career starts (2-5-1 vs Calgary).

**Correlations:** Two key results that seem always to link to winning are **Turnover Ratio** and **Sacks Allowed**. That correlation is never stronger than it is through CFL Week #13. The Top 4 clubs (CGY, TOR, BC, SSK) are a combined **33-15** with a **+38 T/O ratio** (they rank #1-4). The next 4 clubs in the Standings rank #5-8 in T/O Ratio and are a combined 15-33 and -38. This same trend applies to **Sacks Allowed** as well. The Top 4 in fewest Sacks Allowed are again CGY, TOR, BC & SSK averaging 29 per team or 2.4 per game. The four lowest ranked clubs in Sacks Allowed average 43 per team or 3.6 sacks per game and their 15-33 WL record reflects that stat.

**Other Calgary at Hamilton Notes:**

- **Hamilton & Montreal in the Standings:** The Ti-Cats (6-6) are in 2nd place in the East two games ahead of Montreal (4-8). The last time that Hamilton was **two games ahead** of Montreal in the standings was **August 2, 1996** when Hamilton was at 4-2 and the Alouettes at 2-4. It has been 12 years since Hamilton finished ahead of Montreal (2001).
- **Hamilton at 6-6:** This has been their standard in recent years as they have been 6-6 after 12 games in 4 of the last 5 years. The Ti-Cats' 6-game finishing runs have not been above .500 since then: 2009 (3-3), 2010 (3-3), 2011 (2-4), & 2012 (2-4). The last time Hamilton **went above .500 over any season's last 6 games was 2004** (4-2).
- **Henry Burris (169):** Comes into this game with **50,367** career passing yards and needs 169 to pass **Ron Lancaster** (50,535) and move up to #4 among all-time CFL leaders. Burris leads the CFL with 3,765 yards and ranks fifth with a 100.2 efficiency rating. Burris is one of only quarterbacks to have **started all 12 games** thus far (plus Mike Reilly).
- **No two-game losing streaks:** The Stampeders have not posted a **two-game losing streak** since July 2012 - a **span of 27 games**. They are coming off a loss last week and look to avoid a potential tie with either BC or Saskatchewan.
- **Jon Cornish at 1,093 yards / 99.4 per game:** Needs 130 yards to assume the CFL rushing lead past Kory Sheets (1,222). Cornish needs to average 61 yards per game to pass his record for Canadian running backs of 1,457 yards set last year. Cornish is currently ahead of the pace set by Normie Kwong in 1958 when he recorded **95.8 yards per game** on the way to 1,437. Cornish sits at **99.4 yards per game** having missed one outing.
- **Six in a row at 10+ / 9 straight post-seasons:** The Stamps are looking to make it six years running with at least 10 wins and will be in the playoffs for the ninth consecutive year. The club record is 13 years in a row (from 1989 to 2001). They have beaten every other club this year and for the first time since 2010.
- **Calgary Last Week:** The Stamps lost for the first time at home in 2013 allowing 4 TD passes to Zach Collaros, the second time in 4 weeks an opponent has had that many. Calgary led after each quarter and until the final 7:00 when Collaros hit Mike Bradwell with a 34-yard pass. They have now allowed six 30+ completions and 738 passing yards in the last two games. Of the 60 points scored in that game, 24 came after turnovers and Toronto made 13-of-23 2nd down conversions.

- **Hamilton Last Week:** The Ti-Cats won a huge game on their “home” field in Moncton, NB beating Montreal in the 2013 Touchdown Atlantic game. They had their best 4th Quarter of the year outscoring the Als 15-7 with three scoring drives. The winning points came on a pair of field goals by rookie Brett Lauther who went 4-for-4 in his CFL debut. Hamilton won “ugly” as they were outgained, made more T/Os (2-1), had less TOP and first downs (29:46, 19-20) and fewer big plays.
  - **Hamilton Last Week – Special Teams:** Hamilton’s win last week could easily be credited to their special teams. Their net punting was 40.4 to Montreal’s 28.1, they had a 60-yard kickoff return that led to a quick 46-yard TD drive, made all 4 FG attempts and drew only a single return or coverage penalty.
  - **Hamilton of Late:** The Ti-Cats posted a 3-game winning streak a month ago but have gone 2-2 since then. Those two defeats came by margins of just 3 and 4 points including the 26-22 loss to Calgary.
  - **Protecting the passer difference:** As shown above, the Stamps lead the CFL in allowing the fewest sacks with 26. Hamilton sits at the other end having given up 51 including 10 in the last two games. The Ti-Cats have allowed 4 or more sacks eight times this season. Calgary’s Charleston Hughes has a 5-game streak with at least one sack and leads the CFL with 13 (9 in his last 5 games). Hamilton is #8 in sacks made with just 23.
  - **Brett Lauther:** On what was an extremely windy day in Moncton, rookie Brett Lauther was perfect on his first four career FG attempts last week. Replacing Luca Congi (0-for-2 the previous week and 21-of-29 to date), Lauther made two in the final 6:00 of play to give Hamilton a 28-19 lead into the final minute.
  - **Rob Maver:** Has raised his net punting average to 37.3 yards and to within less than half a yard of leader Ricky Schmitt (37.7). Maver is in the midst of an amazing 7-game run in which his net punt has averaged 39.0 yards and without even a single game under 35 net yards per kick.
  - **Larry Taylor:** Leads the CFL in total kick return yardage with 1,628 and on pace for 2,441 yards which would be by far his best year ever (1,971 in 2009). In his career, Taylor is now up to 8,338 yards (KO: 4,584; Punt: 2,881; FGM: 873) which puts him at **#9 all-time** behind Corey Holmes.
  - **Calgary Receivers:** The Stamps have started **NINE different receivers** this year primarily due to injuries to leaders including Nik Lewis and Maurice Price. A total of 17 different players have caught at least one pass this season and from three different QBs plus punter Rob Maver. Six players have the team in receiving in a game and none more than twice in a row. Marquay McDaniel has 11 catches for 152 yards and 2 TDs in the last two games (including 79 YAC yards).
  - **Calgary at 69.9%:** The Stamps’ 69.9% completion mark is the highest in club history and well ahead of the record set just last year of 67.0%. Calgary leads the CFL in pass protection in two ways: 26 sacks allowed and one every 16.0 “drop backs”.
  - **Hamilton vs Calgary:** In their last two games (both losses) vs Calgary, the Tiger-Cats have rung up 476 and 446 net yards and had an edge in Turnovers of 5 to 10 by the Stamps. The losses have come by a total of just 6 points.
  - **Calgary Possession Offence:** They lead the CFL at 32:53 TOP and with a scoring drive 39% of the time (TD or FG), 1 in every 2.5 possessions. Their 2nd down conversion rate of 48.2% is also #1 despite being #6 at 6.2 yards per 1st down play.
  - **Hamilton penalties (5) & 2nd down conversions:** The 5 penalties that Hamilton drew last week were their lowest total in 2013. Their 2nd down conversion rate has dropped off from a fast start: First 8 games - 45%; Last 4 games – 34%.
  - **Scoring margins:** The Stamps are 31 in the CFL in first half scoring margin at +69 (222-153), while Hamilton has the best first quarter margin at +38 (090-52).

## CALGARY GM #13 · CFL #58

### 1 GAME OVERVIEW

The Calgary Stampeders kick off the final third of the 2013 CFL regular season with a visit to the Hamilton Tiger-Cats' temporary home at Alumni Stadium in Guelph, Ont.

The Stamps lead the West Division with a 9-3 record, with one of the Red and White's victories coming at the expense of the Ticats — a 26-22 decision in Calgary on Sept. 13.

Hamilton is 6-6 and occupies second place in the East Division. The Ticats are playing in Guelph this season while their new stadium in Hamilton — slated to open in 2014 — is under construction.

The Stamps are trying to get back on the winning track after last week's 33-27 home-field loss to the Toronto Argonauts snapped Calgary's four-game winning streak.

The Ticats are coming off a 28-26 win over the Montreal Alouettes in Touchdown Atlantic in Moncton, N.B.

This is the second time in three years the Ticats have hosted the Stamps outside of Hamilton. In 2011, the Stamps and Ticats met in Moncton in the second installment of the Touchdown Atlantic series.

Calgary is 4-2 on the road this season while the Ticats are 4-2 at home, including a 3-2 mark in Guelph. Last week's Touchdown Atlantic contest was considered a Hamilton home game.

### 2 STAMPEDERS HISTORICAL NOTES

- Today's game is the 1,113th regular-season game in Stampeders history. The Stamps have 586 wins, 507 losses and 19 ties since 1945. Calgary has played 556 games at home, with a record of 345-201-10, and 556 games on the road (241-306-9)
- This will be the 85th meeting all-time between the Stampeders and Tiger-Cats. The Stamps are 54-30 all-time against the Tabbies including a 21-21 mark as the road team
- The Stamps are 8-2 in their last 10 most recent regular-season games against Hamilton and 5-5 in the 10 most recent road games against the Ticats

#### 6 A LOOK BACK AT CALGARY'S LAST GAME — ARGONAUTS 33, STAMPEDEERS 27

A pair of Calgary streaks came to an end last week at McMahon Stadium as the Stampeders dropped a 33-27 decision to the Toronto Argonauts.

The loss snapped the Stamps' four-game winning streak as well as their 10-game winning streak at home. Their previous loss at McMahon — which came on Aug. 18, 2012 — was also to the Argos.

This latest setback saw the Stamps build a 25-15 lead by the 2:19 mark of the third quarter, only to see the Argos take control of the contest and outscore Calgary 18-2 the rest of the way.

The Stamps committed six penalties in the second half, none more critical than an offensive pass interference call against Jabari Arthur that wiped out a 67-yard touchdown pass to Brad Sinopoli.

After Toronto opened the scoring on a four-yard touchdown pass from Zach Collaros to John Chiles — just two plays after a Patrick Watkins interception — the Stamps rallied with 11 straight points to take an 11-7 lead after one period.

The Calgary points came courtesy of a 52-yard Rene Paredes field goal, an 11-yard touchdown pass from Kevin Glenn to Arthur and a Rob Maver punt single.

After Toronto got a punt single of its own from Swayze Waters, the clubs traded touchdowns to make the score 15-12 at halftime.

First, Stamps quarterback Drew Tate scored on a third-and-goal gamble from the Toronto one-yard line. The Argos replied with a two-yard touchdown shuffle pass from Collaros to Andre Durie.



The Stamps extended their lead early in the third quarter on Glenn's 17-yard touchdown pass to Marquay McDaniel. Toronto quickly answered with a scoring drive that was capped by a 28-yard touchdown catch by Dontrelle Inman.

After tying the game on a 40-yard Waters field goal, the Argos took the lead with a little more than eight minutes to play in regulation as Collaros hooked up with Mike Bradwell on a 34-yard scoring pass.

Singles — two for Calgary and one for Toronto — accounted for the rest of the scoring.

Calgary had a couple of chances in the dying seconds to pull even, but Anthony Parker was ruled to have been out of bounds when he caught a tipped Hail Mary pass in the end-zone. Toronto then recovered a loose ball in the end-zone on the final play of the game when the Stamps completed a pass to Arthur, who punted the ball in an attempt to allow an onside teammate to recover for a touchdown.

Larry Taylor had a great night for the Stamps, racking up 224 return yards. Glenn, making his first start since the Labour Day Classic, threw for 225 yards and two touchdowns.

## 9 THIS AND THAT

- **Stamps clinch playoff berth:** In Week 12, the Stamps became the first team to clinch a spot in the 2013 playoffs. It's the ninth consecutive season the Stamps will take part in the playoffs, with 2004 being the most recent season the Red and White failed to qualify. BC and Montreal are the only teams who have been in the playoffs every year since Calgary last missed out. Thanks to the Week 12 victory over the Tiger-Cats, the Stamps (9-3) are also assured of finishing .500 or better for a sixth straight year. The Alouettes (who are currently 4-8) are the only other team who have a chance to be at least 9-9 in every season since 2008, which is the year John Hufnagel took over as Stampeders head coach and general manager
- **Hughes and Law key sack attack:** Calgary has moved into a share of the league lead in sacks thanks to 27 bagged quarterbacks in the past five games. The attack has been paced by defensive ends Charleston Hughes and Cordarro Law, who have 15 of the 27 sacks in the past five games. The duo has a combined 22 sacks on the season, the best total in the CFL for a pair of teammates
- **Many happy returns:** For each of the past two weeks, Larry Taylor logged more than 200 yards in kick returns. Last week against Toronto, Taylor excelled at kickoff returns with 183 yards in eight opportunities. Taylor leads the CFL



with 1,628 combined return yards and is also first with 541 punt-return yards and is second with 964 kickoff-return yards

- **Ain't he grand:** Jon Cornish surpassed the 1,000-yard mark in rushing this season during the Stamps' Week 12 win over the Tiger-Cats. Cornish, who logged 1,457 yards to win the CFL rushing title in 2012, becomes the seventh player in franchise history to log multiple 1,000-yard seasons, joining a group that also includes Kelvin Anderson, Joffrey Reynolds, Earl Lunsford, James Sykes, Lovell Coleman and Willie Burden
- **Huff reaches 100:** Hufnagel on Sept. 6 became just the second man to coach the Stampeders for 100 games. **Wally Buono** (234 games) is the franchise's all-time leader in games coached
- **Test of time:** Hufnagel (2008-13) is just the second person to coach the Stampeders in six different seasons. Buono (1990-2002) is the other
- **Huff's home record:** The Stampeders are 37-13-1 at home since 2008, the year John Hufnagel took over as the team's head coach and general manager. That is the second-best mark in the league, with Montreal (38-13) being the only team to post more home victories in that span
