A Long Rivalry – Toronto and Hamilton:

Teams from Hamilton and Toronto have been playing each other at football since the 19th Century and in organized league play in a CFL direct predecessor league (the old Big Four) from 1907 to the present. They have played each other a stunning **321 times** since 1907 in one format or another with Hamilton holding an edge of 165 wins to 146 (to go with 10 ties). Counting the 1914 Big Four playoff and the 2013 edition this week, they are meeting in an Eastern Final for only the **9th time in 99 years of play**.

Before 2013, the last time that **Hamilton** met Toronto in the Eastern Final was in **1986**, and that is also the last time that a two-game series format was used to determine the winner and Grey Cup participant from either Division. Here are the most recent Eastern Final and Semi-Final matchups between Hamilton and Toronto going back to **1950** and the birth of the Tiger-Cats out of the merger from two prior clubs (after the 1949 season, the ORFU Tigers and IRFU Wildcats).

- Overall from 1907 to 2013, the Argos have played a Hamilton club (Tigers, Wildcats or Tiger-Cats) 299 times in regular season and another 22 in the playoffs.
- Hamilton leads Toronto in regular season matchups 158 wins to 132 (with 9 ties). In playoff action Toronto has reversed that winning 14 times to Hamilton's 7 (one tie).
- Since 1950, the Argos and Ti-Cats have met **7 times in the East Final** with Toronto winning 4 times and Hamilton 3. Since 1950, they have played each other in **22 different playoff games** with Toronto ahead 14 to 7 and one tie. Those games have covered **15 different years** with Toronto coming out on top 10 times overall to Hamilton's 5.
- They last met in the playoffs in 2010 and 2004 in Semi-Final games but have not met in the Eastern Final **since 1986**. They last met in a single-game final in **1984** in Toronto with Hamilton winning 14-13.
- From 1907 to 1949, the era of the *Hamilton Tigers*, Toronto and Hamilton met in the post-season only once! Their only post-season meeting of that era came **99 years ago in 1914** in a playoff to break a first place tie at 5 wins each. The first game was called on account of darkness and the Argos won the rematch 11-4 to move on to face Hamilton Rowing Club.
- In regular season play, the Tigers and the Argonauts met 73 times between 1907 and 1947 when the Hamilton club departed for the ORFU, a rival league in those days. The ORFU Wildcats took their place and played Toronto 8 times across 1948-49. Since 1950, the Argos and Ti-Cats have faced each other in **218 regular season games**.

CFL NOTES & TRENDS · NOVEMBER 17 · 2013 EAST FINAL**Argonauts Notes:**

- **7-2 Away & 4-5 Home:** The Argos captured first place despite having a losing record at home in 2013 of 4-5. They are the **only team in CFL history to ever win their Division with a losing home record**. Only four other teams won their Division not being above .500 (they finished at 4-4 the most recent being Hamilton in 1985).
 - **Toronto Division Winner / Lowest Ranked Defence:** The Argos are the first division winning club in the CFL to have the lowest ranked defence since Edmonton in 2001 finished #8 in yards allowed but on top of the West Division at 9-9. **They are the only two clubs in CFL history to accomplish that feat.**
 - **Host of the East Final:** This season Toronto wrapped up first place for the first time since 2007. Since their resurgence in 1982 under Bob O'Billovich, the Argos have now finished first and secured host spot in the East Final **10 times in those 32 years**. However they have finished first just 3 times since 1998 (2005, 2007 & 2013). In the 10 Finals they have hosted since 1982, the Argos have gone only 5-5 and have not won at home since 1997.
 - **Frequently in the East Final:** Since 2002 the Argos will now be playing in their 19th of a possible 12 contests missing out only in 2011, 2009 and 2008. They are 2-6 in the previous 8 East Final games.
 - **CFL QB Records:** With his 302 pass attempts, **Ricky Ray** met the qualifying minimum and thus set new single-season CFL records in 2013 for completion % (77.2%), interception % (0.7%) and pass efficiency rating at 126.4. he came within one of the CFL record for consecutive completions with 21 (Oct 24/13 vs Wpg). He had one game under 70% completions.
 - **Argo YAC yards:** Toronto led the CFL in YAC yards with **2,483 - 46%** of their 5,406 passing yards overall. The CFL has been recording YAC yards since 2010 and in those 4 years only one team had more (Calgary with 2,573 in 2010). **Andre Durie** (718) and **Chad Owens** (508) ranked #1-2 in the CFL.
 - **Red Zone success:** The Argos led the CFL in both Red Zone offence with a TD on **70%** of their opportunities, and in Red Zone Defence allowing a TD only **47%** of the time.
 - **Moving the ball:** Toronto had the fewest two-and-outs in 2013 with only 93 despite an average of just 28:36 of TOP. They also forced the fewest at just 90. Their 2nd down conversion rate of 46.2% was #2 in the league – their % was **49%** with Ricky Ray starting, and dropped to **43%** with Zach Collaros at QB.
 - **Ricky Ray vs Hamilton:** Ray has started 22 games against Hamilton as his teams are **15-7** in those contests. This will be his first-ever post-season start against the Tiger-Cats.
 - **Big plays:** The Argonauts generated 10 “big plays” against Hamilton in 2013 including 3 rushes of 20+ yards and 7 completions of 30+. However, they did not have a single big play return among the 10 and their longest punt return was just 19 yards and a long K/O return of 39. Hamilton had two big play returns against Toronto including a kickoff return TD in the season-opener.
 - **Dontrelle Inman:** Comes into this game off a career-high 152 yards in Game #17 and has TD catches in 4 of his last 6 and 5 of his last 8 games.
 - **10+ catches / 90+ yards:** The Argos had **10 players** catch at least 10 passes this season and 11 have at least 90 yards including late season addition Romby Bryant who may start. Bryant had 91 yards, 80 of which were in Game #17 on 7 receptions and that went for 2 TDs.
 - **Swayze Waters FGs:** After starting off making just 10-of-17 (59%) FG attempts to start 2013, Waters made all 8 of his attempts in his final two games of the regular season before sitting out two weeks ago.

**CFL NOTES & TRENDS · NOVEMBER 17 · 2013 EAST FINAL****Tiger-Cats Notes:**

- **Dan Lefevour:** The Ti-Cats backup QB set **an all-time league record for most carries by QB** in a playoff game with 18. He surpassed the 15 carries made by **Matt Dunigan** for Edmonton in 1986. Of his 18 carries, 9 were runs for a first down, just under half of the Hamilton total of 20.
 - **Henry Burris in Playoffs / Div. Finals:** Last week Burris made his **10th career playoff start** and pushed his W-L record to 4-6. He now has a playoff win for three different clubs (SSK 2004, CGY 2008-09, HAM 2013) one short of the CFL record of 4 different teams done by Damon Allen and Matt Dunigan. This week will be his **5th career start in a Division Final game** – 2004 for Saskatchewan, and 2008 to 2010 for Calgary.
 - **Henry Burris vs Ricky Ray – A First:** This week will be their **first ever head-to-head start in a Division Final game**. Burris and Ray have matched up 3 previous times in the playoffs though only 2 of those games were starts for both QBs. They met head-to-head as starters in the 2005 & 2009 West Semi-Finals, as well as the 2nd half only in the 2011 S/F (started by Drew Tate).
 - **Hamilton in the East Final:** Last week's win over Montreal vaulted Hamilton into the East Final for just the second time since 2001, that coming in 2011 at Winnipeg where they lost 19-3. It will be their 34th Division Final all-time.
 - **Hamilton on a roll:** With the win over Montreal, Hamilton has now won **5 of their last 6 games**. They have done that only once (in mid-2010) in the 11 years since 2002.
 - **Playoff experience:** Last week, 24 Tiger-Cats players of their 42 dressed made their CFL playoff/post-season debuts. The Tiger-cats 24 starters from last week now have a combined **71 games** of playoff experience. Of that 71 total, four players - **Henry Burris** (14), **Jamall Johnson** (9), **Andy Fantuz** (9) and **Peter Dyakowski** (5) cover more than half of it.
 - **Hamilton in Playoff OT:** The Ti-Cats won the East Semi-Final in overtime and that makes it 4 times they have gone to extra time in a playoff game since 1950 (three of which have come in their last four playoff years). Hamilton won in OT in 2011 at Montreal, in 1984 at Toronto and in 1961 vs Toronto, and lost in 2009 at home to BC. League-wide going back to 1945, it was the **10th ever playoff game to go to OT**.
 - **Improved Hamilton Defence:** The last two games they have allowed only 280 yards to Montreal and just 192 in the season-ending win over Winnipeg, two of the lowest totals allowed all season.
 - **2nd Half Turnaround:** The Ti-Cats were held to only 81 yards of net offence and 5 first downs by Montreal in the 1st half last week but rebounded to pick up 196 yards and 15 first downs the rest of the way. The 'Cats scored 13 points in the **final 1:04** of regulation plus OT to overcome a 10-6 deficit.
 - **1st Half Turnovers / 0 Points:** Last week, Hamilton turned the ball over 3 times in a stretch of 4 possessions in the 1st half but did not allow Montreal any points at all in the ensuing drives.
 - **Red Zone Defence:** The Ti-Cats defence stopped both Montreal Red Zone chances last week allowing only a field goal attempt (missed) and intercepting Troy Smith on their other chance.
 - **Andy Fantuz:** Led all Hamilton receivers with **6 catches** – that matched his playoff career-high set twice in 2007. He now has 31 career playoff receptions for 430 yards and 2 TDs.
 - **Vs Toronto since 2008:** Hamilton won the season series from Toronto in 2013, and the Argos have won only one series in the last 6 years. Counting all meetings regular and post-season since 2008, Hamilton holds a 12-9 edge.
 - **67 points at Rogers Centre:** In their two visits to Toronto this year, the Ti-cats have scored 67 points including 33 in their last game there on Oct 4/13.

The **2013 Division Semi-Final weekend** can be described as two games decided by a total of 7 points with the winning clubs each trailing in the final quarter, but especially as the "**week of the quarterback run**". **DARIAN DURANT** ran for a career-high 97 yards, 91 of which came in the final 15:01 of the game. Hamilton's **DAN LEFEVOUR** ran for 61 yards, **71 more** than the rest of his team who lost 10 yards on 3 rushes. His total included the TD in overtime, 9 runs for 1st downs and added to Hamilton's two TD drives in the final 1:04 & OT. His **18 carries** shattered the existing record for most QB rushes by a QB in a playoff game.

- **Toronto in 1st Place but 4-5 At Home:**
The Argos captured first place despite having a losing record at home of 4-5. **They are the only team in CFL history to ever win their Division with a losing home record.**
- **Playoff Teams –2013 2nd Half Standings:** Over the 2013 season's final 9 weeks, here's how the 4 finalists ranked:
1. Calgary 7-2 T2. Hamilton 6-3 T2. Toronto 6-3 6. Saskatchewan 3-6
- **Grey Cup Chase from 2nd:** Toronto won the Grey Cup in 2012 from **2nd place** while the previous 4 winners (08-11) came from 1st (and in 7 of the last 11 years). Toronto in 2012 has been the only Semi-Finalist to win the Cup since Saskatchewan in 2007, and the Riders and Ti-Cats will be trying to win on the road to have a chance at Grey Cup 2013 and accomplish the feat.
- **Toronto – Two in a Row?:** Toronto won the Grey Cup in 2012 and will be trying to repeat as Grey Cup champions for the **FIFTH** time in their history. They were repeat winners in 1938, 1946, 1947 and 1997. They will be trying to get to the Grey Cup in consecutive years for the **seventh** time in their history, most recently in 1996-97 and 1982-83.
- **Home vs Away in Playoffs:** In each of the last 10 seasons, at least one road club has won a game including both Division Finals in 2012. Since 1945 there have been 361 playoff games - the home team has won 236 (.659), visitors 121 (.341).
- **Playoff Overtime ... Again:** There have now been 10 playoff overtime games in CFL history and in **4 of the last 5 years** (2009: BC over HAM, 2010: SSK over BC, 2011: HAM over MTL, 2013: HAM over MTL).

1. GAME OVERVIEW

The battle for CFL supremacy in Southern Ontario will add another chapter to its already rich history on November 17. The Argos and Ticats will meet for only the 12th time since 1961. It will also mark the first time the Boatmen host an Eastern Final against the rival Tiger-Cats since 1986.

HISTORIC EDGE? Since 1961, the Argos and Ticats have played 11 post-season games against one another. In those 11 games, the Boatmen hold an 8-3 record, including their most recent victory in the 2010 Eastern Semi-Final at Ivor Wynne Stadium.

PLAYERS TO WATCH

OFFENCE

QB Ricky Ray – Since returning from injury in Week 16, Ricky Ray has been prolific to say the least. In 3 games between weeks 16-18, Ray completed 86 of 114 pass attempts (75%) for 1,084 yards, six (6) touchdowns and two (2) interceptions. In two games against the Ticats in 2013, Ray has completed 50 of 68 (74%) pass attempts for 669 yards, six (6) touchdowns and one (1) interception.

DEFENCE

LB Robert McCune – Named a division All-Star for the first time in his CFL career, Robert “Hammer” McCune has become a staple in the middle of the Double Blue defence. McCune finished with a career best 99 tackles in 2013, and in the three games between the Argos and Ticats this year, McCune finished with 22 total tackles.

SPECIAL TEAMS

K Swayze Waters – After a shaky start to his return to the lineup in Week 10, Waters has been dialed in heading into the post-season. In Waters’ last four games, he has gone a sparkling 13 of 14 (93%) on field goal attempts, including eight (8) straight over his final two regular season games.

In his second year with the Tiger-Cats, Henry Burris led the CFL in passing yards for the second straight campaign with 4,927 yards while throwing for 24 touchdowns on 374-of-568 passing. Over the course of this season, Burris...

- Became the fifth quarterback in CFL history to eclipse the **50,000 passing yards mark** and eventually moved into **fourth all-time** 51,529 yards.
- Became the 39th player and sixth quarterback to run for 5,000 career rushing yards.
- Became the second QB in CFL history to record 50,000 passing yards and 5,000 rushing yards.
- Moved into fourth place on the CFL's All-Time Completions (3,672) and Passing Touchdowns (324) lists.
- Set a new Tiger-Cats single-season completion percentage record by connecting on 65.8% of his throws.
- Threw for the third most completions in Tiger-Cats history (374).
- Won his 100th career game as a starter after leading the Ticats to a 37-7 victory over Winnipeg in week 19.

TEAM MILESTONES

- The Ticats offence set a new club record for first downs in a season with 397, passing the previous mark of 390 set in 2010.
- The Ticats combined for **pass completion percentage of 65.8%** -- a new single-season record. The team previously set the record with a completion of 64.6 in 2012.
- For the first time since 1998, the Ticats won every season series vs. East Division opponents with a division record of 8-2, winning the season series against Winnipeg 4-0, Montreal 2-1 and Toronto 2-1.
- The Tiger-Cats 37-7 victory over Winnipeg in week 19 marked the first time since the 1989 season series against Toronto that the team has won four games versus the same opponent in a season.
- In 64 seasons since emerging to becoming the Ticats in 1950, the Ticats will be making their 50th post-season appearance.
- The Tiger-Cats dressed 88 different players for at least one game exceeding the previous CFL record set back in 1994 by Shreveport and Las Vegas (79). The 57 starters used by Hamilton was also a CFL record.

OTHER NEWS AND NOTES

- Sunday's game in Toronto will mark only the eighth time since 1950 that the Tiger-Cats and Argonauts have met in the Eastern Final. Hamilton has taken the last two games between the two teams in the Eastern Final – 1984 (14-13 in Toronto) & 1986 (59-56 in a two-game Eastern Final series).
- Since becoming the Tiger-Cats in 1950, Hamilton has a record of 18-15 in their 33 appearances in the Eastern Final.
- Tiger-Cats quarterback Henry Burris completed 70-of-106 passing attempts (67.9%) for a total of 985 yards and six touchdowns in three games vs. Toronto. Burris has averaged 328.3 yards passing per game.
- In his only appearance against the Argonauts this season, Greg Ellingson hauled in six receptions for 122 yards in his CFL debut.
- Former Argonauts linebacker Brandon Isaac has recorded eight tackles and two sacks vs. Toronto this season. In his return to Toronto in week 15, he recorded five tackles and two sacks.
- In each meeting with Toronto this season, the Tiger-Cats have amassed 400+ net yards – 408 in week 1, 522 in week 15 and 464 in week 16.
- Canadian receiver Andy Fantuz registered 17 catches for 231 yards and a touchdown against Toronto this season. In week 1, Fantuz amassed a season-high 10 receptions for 155 yards and a touchdown at the Rogers Centre to open the season.
- The Tiger-Cats average time of possession was 31:09 through 18 regular season games. In three games vs. Toronto, the Ticats controlled the ball for a minimum of 32:00 – 32:37 in week 1, 35:08 in week 15 and 37:21 in week 16.
