WEEK #7 · AUGUST 7-9 · CFL NOTES & TRENDS

1. CFL Game #36 Team Notes · Hamilton (1-4) at BC (3-3)

History: Inter-divisional or what was then known as “interlocking” play began in the CFL in 1961 and since then the Lions and Tiger-Cats have met 85 times in the regular season. BC holds a **49-33** edge and there have been three ties. Since 2012 BC had a 3-1 edge in the two season series – but that follows a stretch where Hamilton beat the Lions in 5 of 6 contests. Hamilton has won three times in Vancouver since 2009 – **3 of BC’s 18 home losses in the last six seasons** and less than only Calgary and Edmonton who have made many more visits.

Changing QBs: For Hamilton, in 2014 they have started three different QBs with varying success – but highlighted by recent starter Dan Lefevour. Here’s a reprise of the Hamilton *Game Notes* item after Lefevour’s first career start:

Dan Lefevour 109 / 361: This was one of the most notable performances in CFL history on many levels. Here’s a few takes including his 109 rushing yards, the **56th time in CFL history** a quarterback has gone over the 100-yard mark. Lefevour became the **7th** Hamilton QB to rush for 100+ yards: **Bernie Faloney** 1960 - 102, **Frank Cosentino** 1963 – 128, **Chuck Ealey** 1973 (3 times – max 118), **Ken Hobart** 1985 – 104, **Damon Allen** 1992 – 102, **Casey Printers** 2008 – 125 & **Lefevour** in 2014.

NOT Changing QBs: For the Lions at Calgary, **Kevin Glenn** produced his finest start in Orange & Black with 277 yards on 22-of-32 passes for two TDs. With the pending return to the lineup of regular starter **Travis Lulay**, the Lions announced that Glenn would remain at the helm this week and make his 161st career start (**84-75-1**). In that total are 18 starts against Hamilton – and it is against the Ti-Cats that he has had **his most success**. Glenn’s teams have gone **13-5 in those 18 starts**.

BC Lions:

- **Rare road margin:** The Lions won last week on the road at Calgary for the first time in their last four visits. The rarity of that victory is that it was **by just one point away from home** – only the third time BC has done that in the last **21 years** (once in 2003, once in 2012). In club history, the Lions have won by one point on the road 12 times, three coming at McMahon Stadium.
- **Lions at 3-3 / 2-1 on the road:** BC rebounded to .500 on the season and 2-1 on the road where Western clubs are a combined 10-2. The Lions have now won back-to-back road games for only the second time in their last 17 games away from home.
- **Winning from a losing position - 11+ pts down:** The Lions came back from 11 points down to win in Calgary last week. It was their largest comeback win since **Sep 22/12 at Edmonton** (down 15-3, won 19-18). In club history, the Lions have overcome 11-point deficits to win 25 times in 61 years, but only **three times in the last 6 years**.
- **Andrew Harris:** Even without the 75-yard run for a TD that was negated by penalty last week, Harris added to his lead atop the yards from scrimmage race. He now leads the CFL with 722 in 6 games – on pace for 2,166 yards. The Lions’ club record is **1,873** yards by **Willie Fleming** set in 1963. The 2,000 yard mark has only been reached 20 times in CFL history.
- **Solomon Elimimian - 49 DT:** The Lions LB has led all tacklers in the CFL two weeks in a row with totals of **12 and 10**. He has extended his overall lead to 21 more than teammate **Adam Bighill** who is tied for #2 with 28.
- **Solomon Elimimian - 10+ DT:** Elimimian comes into this week riding back-to-back games of 10+ tackles - Only Chip Cox did that in 2013; J.C. Sherritt had 10+ twice in a row once in 2012, his record-breaking season with 130 DT. Solomon is on pace for **147** defensive tackles. In the 20 seasons since 1995 for which we have highly detailed tackle stats available, **NO CFL player has recorded 10+ defensive tackles in three straight games**. The most in a 3-game span is 31 by Chip Cox in 2013.
- **Glenn’s first road win at Calgary:** Last week was Kevin Glenn’s first win as a visiting starter in Calgary after going 0-8 over his first eight starts there. Glenn now has wins in **11 different stadiums** in his career (including Empire Field, Guelph and Lansdowne Park). Over the last 2 weeks, he has completed 40 passes, and **18 of them** have been of the clutch 2nd down variety.
- **BC’s Turnover Ratio by W-L:** Is -8 in their three losses; +7 in their wins over Saskatchewan, Montreal and Calgary.

1. CFL Game #36 Team Notes · Hamilton (1-4) at BC (3-3)

BC Lions:

- **The Offensive Taylor:** Courtney Taylor has 20 catches for 195 yards in the last three games, the most receptions by any CFL player over that span. Of those 20 catches, NINE of those have been on 2nd down for first downs. He leads the CFL with **12** of those heading into Week #7. Teammate Emmanuel Arceneaux is right behind with 9 clutch catches.
 - **Two 4th Quarter Scoring Drives:** The Lions generated two long scoring drives of **91** and **81** yards in the 4th Quarter at Calgary to overcome the 11-point deficit.
 - **Stingy Defences – Sub 300:** This year, there are still THREE clubs averaging under **300 yards** allowed per game (Edmonton, BC and Calgary). The last time the CFL had three teams go sub-300 in the same year: **1979 - 35 years ago**.

Hamilton Tiger-Cats:

- **Last Week – 1st half/2nd half:** In Dan Lefevour's second career start, Hamilton got off to a slow start as a team gaining just 22 net yards and two first downs in the entire 1st half. The 2nd half however was totally different – Hamilton gained 196 yards, had 11 first downs and NO turnovers. They scored 16 points in the final quarter to pull back from a **17-point deficit**.
 - **Against the West:** The Ti-Cats will be looking to stop a 6-game losing streak against western clubs but are playing the opponent they have beaten the most in recent years, and their most recent western win. The last time Hamilton beat a western club was BC 37-29 on Sep 7/13. Hamilton has defeated BC in 6 of their 10 meetings since 2009.
 - **By 4 points or less:** The Ti-Cats have lost three games by margins of 1, 3 & 4 points this season. Last season the Tiger-Cats went 3-1 in the four games decided by 0-4 points.
 - **So close:** The Tiger-Cats led by 26-20 last week with 1:40 to play and gave tough opposition to Winnipeg right to the end. Winnipeg's winning drives took 11 plays over 94 yards culminating in the Drew Willy lob pass to Nic Grigsby on the final play from scrimmage to tie the game before the convert.
 - **Justin Medlock:** Last week he pinned Winnipeg inside their 20-yard line to start drives four times and once inside the 10. Medlock has pinned an opponent deep 15 times in 2014, tops in the CFL (inside 20). He is third in the CFL at 89% on 8-of-9 FG attempts.
 - **Sacks:** The Ti-Cats rank #9 in the CFL with only 7 sacks and no player has more than one individually.
 - **Dan Lefevour:** Is the only CFL quarterback that currently leads his team in rushing in 2014 - he has 169 yards on 33 rushes.

2. CFL Milestones & Other Trends · 2014 Heading Into Week #7

- **Recent Scoring by Week:** In CFL Week #4, scoring dropped to **31.8 ppg**, the lowest one-week CFL scoring total since **August 5-6, 1980** (31.0 ppg). Since Week #4, scoring has come back strongly at 45 and 48 points per game for Week #5-6.
 - **Lack of 2-point converts:** Through the first six weeks, clubs have scored 107 touchdowns and elected to try a one-point conversion 100 times (99 made). On the 7 two-point convert attempts, **NONE** have been successful.
 - **Kick return TDs:** With Tristan Jackson's 111-yard FG miss return score last week, the CFL is up to four TDs this year. That is on pace for 13 and consistent with the 12 in 2013 and the 14 TDs in 2012.
 - **CFL Command Centre Update:** There have been **28 coach's challenges this year** and 10 have resulted in overturned play results (**Week #6:** 3 challenges, 1 overturned). Of those 28 challenges, 11 have involved defensive pass interference resulting in two changes and nine with no change.
 - **West vs East in 2014 Update:** In a season where to start Week #7 no Western club had any less than three wins or his under .500 the Cross-over rule may become important down the line. The West has an **13-2** edge thus far and may potentially be headed for the **eighth cross-over playoff berth** since the rule was first invoked in 1997 (1997, 2002, 2003, 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2012). The West has won the last EIGHT Inter-divisional games.

 - **Henry Burris (328)**: Needs just 6 TD passes to go beyond Ron Lancaster (333) and move up to #3 all-time. He also needs just 629 yards to go past Danny McManus (53,255) into #3 all-time in yards. Burris has 52,627 heading into this week.

3. CFL Highlight Touchdown · Dobson Collins & Thomas Demarco

ONSIDE KICK TOUCHDOWNS

The CFL's game-by-game scoring records are complete back to **1936** and we have documented **13 occasions** that a player recovered his own team's kick and scored a touchdown on that play.

Last week, Ottawa's **Dobson Collins** was onside behind Thomas Demarco who punted into the Saskatchewan end zone. Collins raced downfield and recovered for a touchdown. It was the first such onside recovery since **July 22, 1999** at McMahon Stadium vs Edmonton when **Scott McKenzie** recovered his own punt and ran 40 yards for a score. Before that **Dick Adams** of Ottawa did the same on **September 12, 1973** with that one being an 80-yard advance of the ball.

RE THE ESKIMOS AND ONSIDE KICK RECOVERIES:

The unique aspect of Collins' feat was that he wasn't the punter on the play. It has been **48 years** since the last time a player performed that feat. EDMONTON'S **Joe Hernandez** recovered a first down **Randy Kerbow** punt on **October 16, 1966** after Winnipeg's Barrie Hansen allowed the ball to bounce; Hernandez advanced the ball 35 yards for the score to end the third quarter.
