1. CFL Game #81 Team Notes · Hamilton (7-8) at Toronto (6-9)

1. Matchup: This game matches two teams that could go a long ways toward settling playoff positioning or simply tie everything up again with two weeks to play. A win by Toronto levels the clubs at 7-9 and would open the door for Montreal to take over first place by themselves, or create another 3-way:

- The Argonauts will be playing a **4th consecutive game at home**, the first time they have done so since **August 1976**.
- The season series is as close as possible with one win each and 46 points apiece; each game was decided by just one point. These were the latest in a long rivalry of close encounters – since 1950 they have played **13 games decided by one point**.
- **Close games:** Toronto (4) and Hamilton (7) have played a combined **11 games** in 2014 decided by 5 points or less.
- **Passing leader matchup:** Toronto and Hamilton rank #1 and #2 in passing yards per game.
- Toronto's win on October 10th snapped a 3-game win streak for Hamilton over the Argos.

2. QB Notables: This game is the third veteran-understudy renewal of 2014 for Ricky Ray & Zach Collaros. **Zach Collaros** is the hottest QB in the CFL averaging **285 yards per game** in the 8 contests he has played since returning from injury and leading Hamilton to 6 of their 7 wins in 2014 during this stretch (6-2). His W-L record is 5-4 on the road and he is now 1-1 vs Toronto. For **Ricky Ray**, this will be his 188th career start and his **16th in a row**. That is his longest consecutive start streak for Toronto and longest since his 31-game streak for Edmonton ended on Sep 23/12 with an injury.

Toronto Argonauts:

- **3-0 required:** The Argonauts need to **win their last three games** to assure a playoff spot in 2014 as do Hamilton and Montreal. A win by BC this week would mean that the 4th place team in the West would have no more than 9 losses and secure a cross-over place. Based on the schedule, barring ties the 3rd place team in the East is guaranteed to have a record no better than **8-10**.
- **3-0 part II:** Toronto needs to finish at 3-0 down the stretch to secure their third straight season at .500 or above. The last time they did that was 2005-2007.
- **Needing 30 points to win:** In their last 19 wins, Toronto has **scored 30+ points in 18 of them**. In their last 17 games without getting to the 30-point mark, Toronto has gone **1-16**; in games scoring 30+ points since October 2011 they are **23-2**.
- **Road vs home – 2014 vs 2013:** Last season, Toronto had the CFL's best road record at 7-2. This season they are only 2-6. They were 4-5 at home in 2013 compared to 4-3 this season.
- **Ricky Ray:** Will be making his 16th straight start for Toronto but is coming off the first game in the last 10 when he did not throw at least one TD pass. He ran off 9 consecutive games with a total of 21 touchdown throws (Aug 1 - Oct 10). Ray is approaching the 52,000 yard mark for his career, a total reached by only four other CFL passers.
- **Chad Owens:** Chad Owens has made at least 6 catches in all 8 games he has played in 2014 and no less than 77 yards in any one of them. Earlier on, Owens had 3 consecutive 100-yard receiving games for the first time in his CFL career. A total of 389 of his 840 yards have come after the catch, 46% of the total.
- **Chad Owens 2:** Leads the CFL in receiving yards (**105.0**) and receptions per game at **8.1**. The only other player to ever average more than 8 receptions per game in a full season was **Derrell Mitchell** in his record-setting season of 1998 (8.9 per game).
- **Swayze Waters:** Has made 25 of his last 26 FG attempts missing only from 28 yards out three weeks ago vs Edmonton. He has **made his last 11 FG attempts from 40+ yards**.
- **Toronto – Back-to-back 1-Point Wins:** The Argos recently won back-to-back one point games. The last time that ANY CFL club won consecutive games by a single point was **Toronto in 1991** (25-24 vs Ott, Sep 29/91 & 22-21 vs Wpg, Oct 5/91).
- **Held out of the Red Zone:** Last week, Montreal's defence kept Toronto out of the Red Zone and they were unable to run a play any closer than the Alouettes' 23-yard line. It was the first time in the last 10 games they did not record a TD on offence.

1. CFL Game #81 Team Notes · Hamilton (7-8) at Toronto (6-9)

Hamilton Tiger-Cats:

Here are the **best turnarounds in CFL history** and Hamilton is on a run to join that group having started 2014 at 1-6. Their turnaround in 2014 matches their own 1985 low point of 1-6 and subsequent **7-2 finishing run to .500**. Rival Montreal has a chance to go one better than the all-time record of recovering from 5 games below .500:

- **When scoring under 20:** Hamilton's defence has allowed them to **win 4 times** in 2014 when NOT reaching the 20-point mark. They have won the last 4 times they did not get to the 20-point mark; in their previous 90 games when were held under 20 points (2000-2013), their record was just **3-87**. They are 4-2 in 2014 when scoring under 20 points.
- **Last week vs Ottawa:** The Ti-Cats moved to 5-0 at Tim Horton's Field and allowed Ottawa only 6 points. It was the second time in 2014 that Hamilton did not allow a touchdown, and the third time holding an opponent under 200 net yards.
- **Winning without a takeaway:** Last week, Hamilton did not force a single turnover and still beat Ottawa. It was only the second time in 2014 a team had won when not creating a turnover - since 1995, teams not forcing any turnovers are **29-198**.
- **Under 60 rushing yards - 5 games in a row:** Hamilton has held their last FIVE opponents to under 60 yards rushing – that is the LONGEST STREAK BY ANY CFL CLUB IN THE LAST 20 YEARS. They have held 7 of their last 8 opponents to less than 60 rushing yards. The Ti-Cats have the #1 run defence in the CFL for the first time since **2000**.
- **82 players:** Heading into Week #18, Hamilton has employed 82 different players on their roster in 2014, by far the highest in the CFL and getting near the CFL record 88 they had in 2013. This week's opponent Toronto has used 75 which is #2 (tied with Ottawa). Across, the CFL a record 640 players have been CFL rosters.
- **Youthful roster:** As of last week, Hamilton's roster consisted of 64 players, 39 of whom are in either their first or second year in the CFL. That represents **61% of the total** far above the CFL average of about half the roster (48%).
- **6 penalties last week:** The Tiger-Cats committed only 6 penalties last week – their lowest total of 2014. Hamilton still ranks #9 in the CFL with 190 penalties – the area where most have come is on offence where they have 68 calls, the most in the league.
- **54 different starters:** Hamilton has used 54 different players in their starting lineup in 2014, and only four have started all 15 games. That is enough for more than two full teams and the two areas most affected have been along the line. They have used 12 different starting O-Lineman and the same number at D-Line.
- **Penalties on Oct 10 vs Toronto:** The last time they met the Argos and Ti-Cats piled up 40 penalties, the **5th highest game total in the last 25 years**. Of those 40 calls, 13 were for either roughing or objectionable conduct; 9 were holding-illegal blocks.
- **Collaros rushing:** The Hamilton starting QB has run 14 times in his last two games for 122 yards, 9 first downs and has had 5 runs of 10+ yards. The previous two games he ran for only 11 times on just 6 carries.

2. CFL Trends · Through Week #17

League-wide Trends:

- **CFL Command Centre Update:** There were **5 challenges** last week (CFL Week #17) and 2 were successful. There have been **88** coach's challenges this year in total (**27** successful) with overturned play results at **31%**. In the season's first 73 challenges (to Game #66), only 20 were overturned for a 27% rate.

In the most recent 11 games since Oct 3/14, **7 of the last 15 challenges (47%)** have resulted in overturned initial rulings.

- **More rushing yards:** In 69 games thus far, the team with more rushing yards has gone **60-9, winning 87% of the time**. Similar results apply for **Turnovers** as teams with even or fewer giveaways are also **60-9**.
- **Recent penalties:** From Weeks #9 to #14 (24 games), the CFL penalty average was just **19.4 per game**. In the last 3 weeks however, there have been **290 penalties in just 12 games**. That is an average of **24.2 per game** or about **25%** more than that previous 6-week span. Hamilton and Toronto play each other again this week – the last time they met they piled up 40 penalties, the **5th highest game total in the last 25 years**.
- **Potential East Semi-Finals:** With three weeks to play and the potential for a cross-over from the West, there still remains **15 possible Eastern S/Final configurations** with any of Hamilton, Toronto or Montreal hosting one another or any Western team except Calgary or Edmonton.
- **Two possible 3-way ties:** Each Division has the potential to end up with a 3-way tie and having to resort to common record among tied clubs to determine playoff positioning. In the East, a possible 8-10 tie exists among Hamilton, Montreal and Toronto should Ottawa win certain games. In the West, if both BC and Saskatchewan run the table (and each would have to defeat Edmonton to do so) those three clubs would wind up at 11-7. Edmonton's common record is the best at this point at 3-0 so far.
- **Three weeks to go · potential for another 3-way Eastern tie:** In CFL East Division history back to 1945 (when schedules became more than just 6 games), before 2014 there had NEVER been a 3-way tie for first place with 4 games to play. This week, if Montreal loses to Ottawa and Toronto defeats Hamilton we will have yet another 3-way tie, this time with just two games left, again a first in East Division history.
- **19 QB Starters:** In 2014, there have been 19 different QB starters and only 2 teams have had just a single player start all of their games (Toronto & Ottawa). Last year, 19 different QBs also started at least one game and all 19 recorded a win. In 2014, only 14 of the 19 have wins. If **Robert Marve** starts for Winnipeg this week vs BC, he will make it 20.

Potential Player Milestones:

- **334 TD Passes:** Ottawa QB **Henry Burris** still needs just one TD pass to go beyond Ron Lancaster who had 333 from 1960 to 1978. Burris has not thrown a TD pass in any of the last 4 games – that is **LONGEST drought without a TD pass in his entire CFL career**. Here is a list of the all-time leaders and their career starts:

- **Elimimian 121 DT / +49:** He needs just 10 more defensive tackles to surpass the all-time CFL record of 130 set by J.C. Sherritt in 2012. Solomon is 54 tackles ahead of #2 teammate **Adam Bighill**, the largest gap over #2 in CFL history; the existing mark is +32 by Willie Pless (116 vs 84) in 1997 over Calvin Tiggie. Elimimian's 121 total now matches the **2nd largest in CFL history** recorded by **Calvin Tiggie** in 1994.
- **Elimimian Part II:** With 8 special teams tackles as well, Elimimian's total of 129 overall stops is just 7 short of matching the CFL record of **136 total tackles** set by **George White** for Calgary in 2005. Elimimian's 129 total tackles is the #2 highest number of all-time, two more than Calvin Tiggie's 127 in 1994 (121 DT & 6 STT).



WEEK #17 · OCTOBER 17 - 19 · CFL NOTES & TRENDS

Potential Player Milestones:

- **Paul McCallum:** Paul became the CFL's **#2 all-time scorer** at **2,999** career points passing Mark McLoughlin two weeks ago. McCallum is also now at 322 GP and holds the **#5** all-time spot there. He can reach 3,000 career points in Week #18.
- **Lirim Hajrullahu (33-of-37 FGs):** Ranks #2 the CFL in FG% at **89.2%** and is on pace to break the all-time Winnipeg club record held by Justin Palardy at 86.7%. **For first-year CFL players**, the existing FG% record is held by **Justin Medlock at 86.96%** which he set in 2009 making 40-of-46 attempts. Harullahu can afford to miss only one more attempt in his final 2 games and still set the **1st Year mark** provided he tries at least 2 or more FGs (i.e. if he goes 1-of-2 Lirim ends up 34-of-39 or 87.18%).
- **10+ QB Sacks:** In 2014, there are **8** players who have either already reached a double-figure sacks total. The last time that as many as 9 players had 10 or more QB Sacks was in **1993**. And three players are each within one of hitting 10.
- **5 Forced Fumbles:** The CFL has been recording forced fumbles since 1997 and in that 18-year span **only 9 players** have ever had more than 5 in one season. This year **Odell Willis, Teague Sherman, Shawn Lemon** and **John Bowman** all have a chance to join that group as they lead the CFL with 5. Bowman is now up to 23 forced fumbles in his career while Willis has 19.
- **Swayze Waters:** Leads the CFL in scoring with 161 points and is on pace for 193, the most by any Toronto player since Mike Vanderjagt had 198 in 1996. Vanderjagt was the last Toronto player to top the CFL that coming in 1997 with 190 points.
- **Jon Cornish:** Jon Cornish needs just **118** rushing yards this week to **pass six players in a single game** on the CFL's all-time rushing list. Cornish ranks **#24** with 6,117 career yards and sitting at **#18** is former Stampeder Willie Burden with 6,234. Having played just 8 games, Cornish can match Michael Richardson's mark of leading the CFL in rushing with the fewest played (11 GP).
- **Dexter McCoil:** With his 77-yard fumble return score two weeks ago, McCoil now has 3 defensive touchdowns in 2014. In CFL history, only 5 players have ever recorded more than 3 defensive TDs in one season and 24 have recorded 3 or more:

- **Ricky Ray:** Leads the CFL with **27 TD passes** and is on pace to end up as **#1** in the league for the first time in his career. Since 1961, only two Toronto QBs have led the CFL in TD passes - Gilbert Renfroe in 1988 and Doug Flutie in 1996 & 1997. Ray's narrow career lead over **Dave Dickenson** for career completions % sits at **67.59%** (4,155 of 6,147) to **67.52%**.
- **100 Career Games:** **Diamond Ferri** reached 99 career games last week and is just one GP away from the century mark.

GAME OVERVIEW

SINKING SYNCHING WITH TICATS: Kick return/receiver Terrell Sinkfield has been featured in a number of ways since arrive in Hamilton. The first-year Ticat has compiled a total of 642 combined yards on 25 touches - an average of 25.7 yards per touch. In his four appearances in Black & Gold, he has averaged a total of 160.5 combined yards per game and recorded a play of 40+ yards – 57-yard punt return TD in week 12, 52-yard kickoff return in week 15, 51-yard punt return in week 16 and a 43-yard carry in week 17.

HOLDING THEIR GROUND: Hamilton has held their last five opponents to under 60 yards rushing – the first time Hamilton has done that in a decade. The last time they limited opponents to less than 60 yards on the ground was June 25, 2004 to July 20, 2004. The Ticats have the #1 run defence in the CFL, allowing an average of 74.1 yards per game and 4.5 yards per attempt. The last time they finished with the best run defence was back in 2000 and before that in 1987.

NORWOOD'S SACKS: Eric Norwood has been on a tear since returning to the Ticats lineup in week 12, recording a total of 10 quarterback sacks in six games since his return. After registering three tackles and a sack in last week's 16-6 victory over Ottawa, he now leads the East Divisions and is tied for third in the CFL with a total of 12 sacks, and has also recorded a sack in six of his last seven starts.

OTHER NEWS AND NOTES

- Last week vs. Ottawa, LB/DB Rico Murray recorded 5+ tackles for the fifth consecutive game.
- Last week against Ottawa, the Tiger-Cats rushed for a total of 207 yards, the team's highest rushing total of the 2014 season.
- Dating back to 2008, the Tiger-Cats have won four of the last six season series against the Toronto Argonauts – the 2009 season-series ended in a 2-2 tie. Heading into Saturday's game in Toronto, the Ticats have 13 of the last 21 meetings between the rivals.
- The Tiger-Cats offence has averaged 309.2 passing yards and 71.5 rushing yards in two games vs. Toronto.
- In two games vs. Toronto, Zach Collaros has completed 71.4% of his passing attempts for a total of 619 yards and three touchdowns. He has also added 79 rushing yards and a touchdown on the ground.
