Feline Pre-Anesthetic Consent Form**

Like you, our greatest concern is the well being of your pet. Before putting your pet under anesthesia, we will perform a full physical examination. However, many conditions are not detected unless blood screening is performed. Our laboratory is fully equipped and staffed to perform these important blood tests. Results will be immediately available to examine before anesthesia and/or surgery. All of these additional procedures are recommended, but not required. We will discuss the additional cost when your pet is dropped off for surgery.

PRE-ANESTHETIC BLOOD SCREEN: This test can help us detect disorders of the liver, kidneys and blood. For these reasons, we recommend blood screening before anesthetic procedures. **(Required over 3 years of age)**

FELINE LEUKEMIA/AIDS TEST: Leukemia and AIDS are contagious, often fatal diseases in cats. These viruses can be harbored for long periods of time without causing illness.

STOOL SPECIMEN: (Fecal Test) This test allows us to detect intestinal parasites (worms) that can be harmful to your pet and can be transmitted to humans, especially children.

MICROCHIP PLACEMENT: Would you like your pet to have a microchip implanted while here? This would aide in identifying your pet if he/she were lost.
