16 Weeks

- Physical Exam

- FVRCP Vaccination
- FIP Vaccination
- FeLV Booster

6 Months

- Spay / Neuter
- Rabies Vaccination – 1 year

Yearly

- Fecal Exam
- FVRCP Vaccination
- FeLV Vaccination
- FIP Vaccination
- Rabies Vaccination – **REQUIRED BY LAW** –2 year, unless never vaccinated before

* For a Fecal Exam, a small amount of stool (approx. 1 tsp) is checked under the microscope for intestinal parasites such as Roundworms, Hookworms, Whipworms, and Tapeworms. The sample can be dropped off any time within 8 hours of collection.

** The FVRCP vaccination includes Feline Rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus, Panleukopenia, and Chlamydia Psittaci.
