CANINE VACCINATIONS

Cosmetic procedures such as tail docking and dew-claw removal should be done when puppies are 2-4 days old. If ear cropping is desired, it should be done at 8-12 weeks of age.

16 Weeks

- ~ Physical Exam

6 Months

- ~ Physical Exam
- ~ Spay / Neuter
- ~ Rabies Vaccination – 1 year

Yearly

- ~ Physical Exam
- ~ Fecal Exam
- ~ DA2LPP+CV Vaccination
- ~ Lyme Vaccination
- ~ Bordetella Vaccination
- ~ Rabies Vaccination – **REQUIRED BY LAW**- 3 year, unless never vaccinated

* For a Fecal Exam, a small amount of stool (approx. 1 tsp) is checked under the microscope for intestinal parasites such as Roundworms, Hookworms, Whipworms, and Tapeworms. The sample can be dropped off anytime within 8 hours of collection.

** The DA2LPP +CV vaccination includes Distemper, Adenovirus Type 2, Leptospirosis, Parainfluenza, Parvovirus, and Corona Virus. At 6 weeks, the vaccine is given without Leptospirosis.

*** Heartworm Preventative should be given monthly, year-round, to prevent fatal infestation of heartworms. The medication is dispensed by weight, so current weight checks are necessary.
