Laboratory Tests Waiver

If your pet is to be anesthetized, rest assured that advances in anesthesia and surgery have made routine procedures relatively safe with a low rate of complications. Nevertheless, occasional problems can arise due to pre-existing conditions not evident during routine pre-anesthetic examinations. We recommend that prior to anesthesia, the following laboratory tests be performed and that you will be charged for them. Please initial to approve for these procedures.

Pre Surgical Bloodwork It is our job to ensure that your pet can properly process and then eliminate the anesthetic he or she is given. Before we perform any procedure that requires anesthesia, we run tests to confirm that your pet's organs are functioning properly and to reveal any hidden health conditions that could put your pet at risk.
