New Advancements in Flea Control

The active ingredient in Comfortis, spinosad, was introduced in 1999 for use in agriculture and received a "Presidential Green Challenge Award" by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. It works by interfering with the flea's neuro-transmission and causing it to die before it can lay eggs! Clinical studies have shown it to be safe and effective when

administered along with commonly used veterinary medications.

Comfortis may be especially appealing to dog owners who do not want to use one of the topical products. There is no tube to deal with, it can't be rubbed or shaken off, swimming and bathing do not decrease its effectiveness, and your dog can be played with immediately. There is no risk of application site reactions because it is given orally. It has been demonstrated safe for dogs 14 weeks and older.
