However, we highly recommend a pre-op blood profile to be performed for the purpose of insuring your pet to be in low risk category during anesthesia.

By performing this important pre-op blood profile, we will be able to rule out any pre-existing internal problems that may not be evident physically, but could lead to serious complications. require more extensive pre-anesthetic blood work. Even in animals under one year old, blood
work will occasionally detect abnormalities that could affect anesthesia.
