These standards include diagnostic services, pain management, pharmaceuticals, medical records, etc. Only 12% of the animal hospitals in the US and Canada are accredited, and we're one of them!

We are also members of the American Association of Feline Practitioners. The doctors here understand how stressful a trip to the vet's office can be for both the feline patient as well as their owner. Our office has a separate feline entrance and waiting area, a feline-only exam room, staff certified in feline behavior, and our team is trained in feline

restraint to provide a calm and stressfree visit for both of you.

Services offered include preventative care, digital radiology, behavior modification, dental prophylaxis, in-house comprehensive lab work, bathing, boarding, and more.

For owners seeking alternative treatment therapies, we offer a range of nutraceuticals and perform therapeutic laser therapy for an array of conditions. The laser aids in the treatment of bacterial, fungal, and viral infections, improves blood flow/circulation, repair nerve damage, and relieve pain and inflammation in pets suffering from arthritis.

If you are tired of calling for medication refills, food orders, toys, or supplements our website has an online store & pharmacy that ships directly to your door! Now you can get the same medications, backed by their manufacturers, without ever leaving the comfort of your own home. (Many products sold through internet pharmacies are obtained through illegal methods and are stored incorrectly, expired, or come from overseas.)

Our hospital features a one of a kind rear play yard for all our canine boarders. The combination of ecofriendly synthetic grass, in-ground drainage system, and eight-foot privacy fencing create a wonderful and safe environment for your pet while they play one-on-one with one of our kennel assistants.

Appointments:

We strive to provide the best medical care available for your pets. We ask that you call and schedule an appointment to ensure that we can spend the appropriate amount of time with you and your pet in order to address all of your questions and concerns. Walk-in appointments will be accepted depending on the current appointment schedule. In the event that we cannot get you worked in within an hour of your arrival we will ask to schedule an appointment for a later time. All pets MUST be on a leash or in a carrier before entering the hospital.

Payment:

Payment is due at the time of rendered services. In some cases, a pre-payment may be required. We accept cash, check, VISA, Master Card, Discover, American Express, & Care Credit. We do not offer payment arrangements.

Emergencies:

If you have an emergency, please call us immediately so we are prepared for your arrival. By calling us before driving here, or while on the way, we are able to prep the technicians and a doctor so we can care for your pet in a timely manner. Please understand that in certain situations we may direct you to the Animal Emergency & Trauma Hospital in Wilmington for the most appropriate care for your pet.

Boarding:

We offer boarding for your pets in size appropriate accommodations. We have runs for the larger dogs, cages for the smaller dogs, and cat boarding located at the opposite end of the hospital. We can also board other species, but please check with us first. We ask that you call ahead to make a reservation to ensure we are able to accommodate them. All of our boarding pets must have a current exam with one of our doctors along with current vaccinations. There is a boarding registration form available on our website,

www.BrunswickForestVet.com, explaining all our requirements and policies. Holiday boarding drop-off and pick-up times may vary.

Prescription Refills:

We have a 24-hour refill policy to ensure that all of your pet's medications are filled and ready when you come to pick them up. All prescriptions must be reviewed by a doctor prior to approval and filling. Certain medications are special orders and necessitate advanced notice for refills; we will notify you if your pet is prescribed something that needs to be special ordered.

Surgery:

We perform a wide range of surgical procedures which can be scheduled Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays. For patients having a surgical procedure, no food is allowed after 8pm the night before, though water is allowed. Due to the serious nature of any anesthetic event, we place intravenous catheters, administer intravenous fluids, and perform pre-surgical blood work for most procedures. All surgery patients are to be dropped-off with us between 8-8:30 am the morning of the procedure. Unless otherwise informed, all patients will go home the same day between 2-5:30 pm.
