\_\_\_ **Pain Management (in-patient)**      \$44.50  
Pain management that is administered prior to surgery

\_\_\_ **Pain Management (out-patient)**      \$10.00-25.00  
Short term pain management that can be given at home as needed, usually for 3-5 days

\_\_\_ **Nail Trim**      \$6.90  
Stress free nail trim while under anesthesia

\_\_\_ **Blood Screen**      \$75.70-149.50

*\*\*For best value, please schedule lab work to be performed prior to surgery date.*

All patients, not just the old or sick, should have basic pre-anesthetic blood tests performed checking the kidney and liver values, red blood cell count and total protein. Many animals will require more extensive pre-anesthetic blood work. Even in animals under one year old, blood work will occasionally detect abnormalities that could affect anesthesia.

\_\_\_ **ResQ Microchip**      \$55.50

Millions of pets are lost every year. A tiny microchip about the size of a grain of rice fits in a hypodermic needle just like a vaccination and it injected under the skin where it remains safely for the life of your pet. The ResQ Microchip is recognized internationally and has no annual fee.

\_\_\_ **IV Catheter w/Fluids**      \$47.50

Placement of an IV catheter provides the following for your pet: Maintaining adequate BLOOD PRESSURE throughout the procedure, aids in QUICKER RECOVERY, provides proper ELECTROLYTES and corrects and maintains HYDRATION status, allows for ADMINISTRATION of various MEDICATIONS (pain, life saving, antibiotics etc.)

\_\_\_ **Heart Monitoring**      \$44.50

Our advanced Anesthesia Monitoring equipment allows us to take various BLOOD PRESSURE readings throughout the procedure, an electrocardiogram (EKG) to monitor the heart rhythm for arrhythmias, a pulse oximeter to monitor the percentage OXYGENATION of the blood, which should be close to 100%.

\_\_\_ **Clean & Polish Teeth**      \$27.00

Based on in-depth research we understand how important proper dental hygiene is to our pet friends. Periodontal disease is not only locally aggressive on individual teeth, but the impact on the entire body can potentially cause great harm. Periodontal disease increases significantly with age and most pets over the age of 2 have some form of dental disease.

\_\_\_ **Elizabethan Collar**      \$13.10-20.30

Pets can seriously injure themselves by licking and chewing and it is impossible to monitor them 24 hours a day. An E-Collar is a plastic cone-shaped collar that helps prevent your pet from licking or chewing at the incision site.
