To help you as the owner plan for a healthy life with your kitten or cat, we have provided a list of procedures and fees that we offer. Please call us if you have any question about the fees or other services not provided on this sheet.

Physical Examination	\$43.00
Fecal (annually)	\$18.00
Nail Trim (routine)	\$11.00
Nail Trim (difficult)	\$21.00
Avid Microchip	\$38.00
FLT/FIV (leukemia/Aids testing)	\$40.00

Feline Vaccines:

The FVRCP (distemper, calicivirus, rhinotracheitis) vaccine is given by a doctor at age appropriate times and includes a full examination and complimentary nail trim.

FVRCP 1,2 (beginning before 12 wks old)	\$30.50
FVRCP (adult – 4 months & older)	\$47.50

The initial Leukemia vaccine will need to be boosted in 3-4 weeks, then annually. The vaccine is not required by law but is highly recommended for felines who go outside or if there are other animals going in and out doors. The felines must be tested for FLT/FIV before receiving the vaccine.

FLVP (adult vaccine)	\$54.00
FLVP (with another vaccine)	\$23.00

The Rabies vaccine is not required by Michigan Law but strongly recommended. Starting at age 12 week, the first rabies vaccine can be given and will need to be boosted in 1 year, then every 3 years after that. We do recommend an annual exam to ensure your pet is healthy.

RABIES (with an exam)	\$45.00
RABIES (with no exam)	\$26.00
RABIES (in addition to FVRCP)	\$19.00

Pre-surgical Blood work:

We recommend pre-anesthetic bloodwork prior to all types of surgery. The pre-anesthetic bloodwork will give us a complete CBC and chemistry. This will screen for any underlying potential problems that may complicate anesthesia. This is not a mandatory test, but is strongly recommended for older pets or pets with a history of concerns.

Female (spay) Ovariohysterectomy:

Prices may increase due to age, intra-abdominal fat, pregnant, status of cycle or other complications. Must weigh at least 2 pounds and 12 weeks or older.

Spay (female feline)	\$127.00

Male (neuter) Castration:

Must weigh at least 2 pounds, and be at least 10-12 weeks old and both testicles must be present.

Neuter (male feline)	\$83.00

Feline Dental:

An examination and estimate are strongly recommended, if not seen in the last 2 months, before scheduling a dental for your cat. This is to ensure that your cat does not need an antibiotic before surgery and to give you, the owner, an idea of the costs if any extractions are needed.

Surgical Declaws:

These prices include pain medication, based on a weight of 10 pounds and under.
