### Prepare your pets for Fireworks!

We hate to see our pets stressed out when they hear fireworks. Why not keep some tranquilizers on-hand just in case? Try catnip for cats (You can buy fresh catnip at Lowe's or Home Depot.). For dogs, we have Thundershirts, which wraps snugly around his chest and gives him a "hug" and helps calm him down. Thundershirts help anxious car-travelers, too!

Bring your pets inside New Year's Eve to keep them from running away. Try closing the curtains, turning on the TV or radio to drown out the noise of the fireworks. Take your dog on a long walk before fireworks start to work off nervous energy.

If you must leave your pet outside, make sure he has tags on his collar with phone numbers or has a microchip (which can be implanted here for only \$46 and will never fall off like tags would!).

### TOUR THE CLINIC

If you haven't had a chance to

\*We offer boarding for your dogs,  
cats and birds! Have a special needs  
pet (diabetic, elderly...)? No prob-  
lem! Dr. Torchia and our experi-  
enced vet assistants provide gentle-  
loving care for them during their  
stay. Call us to make your reserva-  
tion before it fills up! (We require a  
\$50/pet boarding  
deposit to save your  
pet's spot.)



\*Is your pet traveling  
with you? Ask us  
about tranquilizers or medications to  
prevent car-sickness. If you pet is  
flying with you, a health certificate  
is required. Check with your airline  
for their regulations on health certifi-  
cates.

\*Remember to give your pet's heart-  
worm and flea/tick prevention.  
Here, in the Southeast, pets are sus-  
ceptible to heartworms, fleas and  
ticks year-round. Cats can get heart-  
worms, too (even totally indoor  
cats)! Ask us what you can do to  
keep your dog *and* cat protected.

\*Is your pet on medications? Call  
ahead so we can have your pet's  
medication ready when you walk in  
the door. Keep in mind that UPS  
and FedEx have holiday hours and  
some medications require us to make  
a special order that may take a few  
days to arrive.
