

Dental care is one of the most important preventative measures that you can do to help keep your pet healthier during their lives. Today your pet is scheduled to have an oral assessment and cleaning performed. During this assessment, we may find problems that need additional treatment. Each tooth will be carefully evaluated so we can choose the best treatment. Since most pets require sedation before a doctor can complete a thorough dental exam, exact charges for any additional treatment are impossible to predict. To help you avoid surprise charges, a staff member will call you to update this estimate during the procedure if additional services are needed. We recommend completing all needed dental procedures during this visit so you can avoid scheduling another appointment with additional sedation costs. The following is a listing of charges for commonly needed adjunctive treatments.



• Additional anesthesia time		\$ 46.50 / ½ hour
• Extraction pack/suture (minimum charge)		\$ 32.00
• Extractions (charges are based on time and difficulty)		\$ 4.00 / minute
• Oravet application		\$ 25.00
• Oravet Home care kit (lasts 8-16 wks)		\$ 28.50
• Consil bone matrix implant		\$ 59.00
• Perioceutic application		\$ 59.00
• Gingivectomy		\$ 10.00 / tooth
• Oral surgery (ex. oro-nasal fistula/mass excision)		\$ 5.00 / minute
• Digital X-Ray (first)		\$ 36.00
• Digital X-Ray (additional)		\$ 16.00
• Digital X-Ray (full mouth)	Cat/sm dog	\$ 60.00

• Enamel sealents		\$ 25.00

Example:

During a routine cleaning, an upper fourth premolar (chewing tooth) is found to have a slab fracture. An X-ray of the tooth is taken and one of the three roots is found to be abscessed. A decision to extract the tooth is made. The extraction and gingival repair takes an additional 30 minutes to perform. A nerve block is performed on the tooth prior to the extraction.
