If you can not be reached immediately when a decision must be made for the care of your pet do wish us to:

_____ Do not Proceed without speaking to you first. You understand that this may mean not performing a procedure or completing a procedure until you can be reached and may cause your pet prolonged or additional anesthesia.

Do you want your pet to have microchip identification placement-A tiny microchip is inserted under the skin between the shoulders. Most Humane Shelters and Animal Control agencies scan pets that are brought in allowing your pet to be identified even if the collar is lost. This type of identification is especially important in the event of a natural disaster. The ideal time for insertion is during any sedation.

Pre-Anesthesia Laboratory

Your pet is being admitted for surgery today. We will perform a physical exam prior to the procedure but many conditions, including disorders of the liver, kidneys, or blood may pose a threat to your pet and can only be detected through blood testing. This lab work is for the safety of your pet. Your pet's doctor will review the lab work prior to anesthesia. It must be understood that there is no guarantee that problems with anesthesia will be eliminated simply as a result of the laboratory testing but it is a crucial tool in allowing us to determine the health of your pet.

Your pet's doctor will discuss the type of lab work he/she recommends and the fee should that be of concerns.

Intravenous Fluids

For your pet's protection we require the placement of an intravenous catheter in all animals receiving anesthesia. Patients will receive intravenous fluids for the duration of their procedure. This is provided at no additional fee.

Pain Medication

For all surgical patients, a pre-operative injection will be administered for pain relief and pain medication may be prescribed to go home. The cost for these medications will be additional to the cost of the surgery being performed. The dosage for these medications will vary, depending on the size of your pet and the length of time the medication will be needed. Estimated pain medication cost.....\$22.00-\$45.00
