 - Andrea Seymour wants to play on a U-15 team. She is only allowed to play for this team in the fall. Traci raised a motion to approve and seconded by Sue.
 - Twin sisters want to play for the U-14 Bomberz. Traci raised a motion for them to play in the fall only, seconded by Sue. All in favor none opposed. They will need to move to another team in the spring.
