

GREAT BASIN YOUTH SOCCER LEAGUE MEETING

Meeting was called to order at 6:31 p.m.

Quorum obtained.

Minutes from the last meeting: moved to approve by Pam, second by Richard. All in favor, none opposed.

Board reports:

President

- We need to fill the position of Vice-President and Treasurer next year. Jeannie and Ralph are not running again.
- The position for Northern VP and Commissioner may be open too.

Vice-President

- Nothing to report.

Secretary

- Written report submitted.

Treasurer

- Written report submitted.
- The bad check fee is now \$25.00.
 - Any team that paid the league with a bad check should be on bad standing until they pay the check plus the administrative cost of \$25.00.

Registrar

- Everything is good.

Northern VP

- You now need 30 days prior notice for travel papers.
- Guidelines regarding travel papers will be given out on the coaches' mandatory meeting next year.

League Commissioner

- In 2007, all U-12 is 8 V 8. In the upcoming state meeting, the guidelines regarding field size and goals will be decided.
- An agreement was reached between the State and Best Western Hotels. A rebate will be presented to the state if our teams will be staying at their facilities.
- Referees will be notified that U17 and U19 is allowed to have a 22 man roster. However, only 18 is suited up for each game.
- Licensing classes are scheduled in December. She asked to postpone this until January due to holidays.
- For background checks on coaches, Rich and Sue have to notify all the coaches that this check will be done in random.
- The State set up a rule that players can play up to 2 age groups for the North only. Beyond the 2 age group has to be approved by the board.

- Scott Connors is the new SYRA .
- When the referee reported physical and or verbal abuse committed by the coach, a letter notifying the coach that he/she can't step into the field without first going to a disciplinary hearing before the committee.
 - The committee can suspend a coach as soon as possible. The coach can then request a hearing.
- The top 4 teams will be seeded for the State Cup. The State will hire a group to run the Cup. There will be four officials on every game.

Regional Team

- Stacy informed the board that 30 boys tried out for the 1992 team and 22 made the team. 47 girls tried out for the girls teams and 24 is on the roster.

- The scholarship request need to be forwarded to Rich. Names need not be mentioned.

- **The league had asked NNRA for better coverage of the game, better trained referees, increase in recruitment efforts and mentoring programs. The NNRA had asked for pay increase which the league agreed to but the demands that we presented to them had not been adhered to. The league is now going to form its own referee association.**
 - **The State had offered to train. AYSO referees can become league referees as long as the form is signed by their commissioner.**
 - **The board members had suggested a youth mentoring program and the League will pay for the whole thing.**
 - **Pam raised a motion for GBYSL to create a referee association strictly for youth games. This was seconded by Rich. All in favor, none opposed.**
 - **A motion for the club to announce to their team members that each team will need to have at least 1 referee was approved unanimously. None opposed.**
 - **The members of the referee committee are Rich Welsh, Richard Jay, Pam Calhoun, Jeannie Knowles, Ron Flickinger and Traci Ferrante.**
 - **A \$2000.00 budget was proposed by Pam and seconded by Barry Wardell. All in favor, none opposed. This money is to be used for the referee association.**
