- Trophies will be handed out to the first and second place of each division. A big trophy and medals will be awarded to the first place and a smaller trophy and medals for the second place.
- The website is going pretty quickly. A continuous message board will be set up for the kids to be able to chat with other players.

Treasurer

- \$10,520.00 will be transferred from the general account to the field account.

RSU

- The Start-Up Tournament went well except for the weather.
- Maria has to check with the appropriate people regarding the information on the website for the cancellation of games at South Valley. Also RSU Crush's points were posted at 10 and should be 11.

NEW BUSINESS

- The processing fee is chaired until further notice.
- The summer tryout dates can start on July 10, 2005 for a 2 week period.
- The start of the fall season is the first Monday after Labor Day weekend.
- Pam moved that \$5.00 be charged for every replacement card. This was seconded by Debbie. All in favor, none opposed, no abstentions.
- The league will charge any city or county's fees plus \$10.00 for any equipment left on the field that the city/county have to move. Motion made by Ralph, seconded by Sue. All in favor, none opposed, no abstention.
- Mission statement is chaired until further notice.
- Starting today, the \$30 processing fee for player changes is revoked per suggestion of the state.
- 3 v 3 tournament is coming in July 2005.
- Red card received on a US Club Soccer games is a red card for USYSNV also.

LEAGUE COMMISSIONER

- We have received several complaints from parents about the foul language being used by our players around children in the playground area. The referee association will be notified that they have to start issuing red cards to players before, during and after the game for foul languages.
- One of the bylaw changes at the state workshop will directly affect us. We will have less votes as a league because the south is getting an influx of new leagues. There will be 1 delegate per 500 players. It is presently at 300. This stipulation still needs to pass.
