# **Country Birdhouse Project Sheet**







# Top Card (fun fold)

### Cardstock:

- Petal Pink 8-1/2 x 5-1/2, score at 4-1/4, 4-1/4 x
  3, and scrap for birdhouse trim
- Early Espresso: 2-3/8 x 2-3/8 for birdhouse trim and ½" circle
- Basic White: 5-1/4 x 4, 2-1/4 x 2-1/4 for birdhouse trim, and scrap for greeting, flowers, and bird

Country Woods patterned paper: 3-1/4 x 2-1/2 Country Lace patterned paper: 4 x 2-3/4 Embellishments of your choice

Fold Petal Pink cardstock on scoreline. Cut 2-1/4" off one end. Place fold on the top with shorter side on top. Adhere white insert inside card.

Adhere Country Lace patterned paper to remaining Petal Pink cardstock and then adhere to the top front of the card (tip: only put glue on the top part of this piece).

Die cut the birdhouse and 3 trim pieces and adhere together with liquid glue. With Dimensionals, adhere to the front of the card. Adhere the ½" circle of Early Espresso to the birdhouse.

Stamp a greeting on 5/8 x 3 scrap of white cardstock and die-cut. Adhere to card front with liquid glue in the middle and a Dimensional on either end.

Stamp the bird and flowers and color them with Blending Brushes. Die-cut. Adhere the bird with liquid glue. Adhere the flowers with Dimensionals.

Embellish as desired.

# Middle Card

#### Cardstock:

- Pecan Pie: 8-1/2 x 5-1/2, score at 4-1/4, and 2-3/4 x 2-1/2
- Basic White: 5-1/4 x 4 and scrap for bird, flowers, and greeting
- Bubble Bath: 5-1/4 x 4

Country Woods patterned paper: 5-1/8 x 3-7/8 White Baker's Twine Embellishments of your choice

Fold Pecan Pie cardstock on scoreline, placing fold at the left. Adhere Bubble Bath cardstock on card front and then the Country Woods patterned paper on top. Adhere Basic White cardstock inside.

Die-cut birdhouse stand from Pecan Pie cardstock and adhere to card front.

With black ink, stamp the bird on scrap of Basic White cardstock, die cut, and color with Pool Party Stampin' Blends. Adhere to card front with Dimensionals.

With black ink, stamp 3 sets of flowers on Basic White cardstock, die cut, and color with Pool Party and Bubble Bath Stampin' Blends. Overlap and adhere to cardfront with liquid glue.

On ½ x 2-1/2 scrap of White, use Pecan Pie ink to stamp a greeting; adhere to card front with Dimensionals.

Tie a double bow from White Baker's Twine and adhere with a glue dot. Add embellishments.

# **Country Birdhouse Project Sheet**

# **Bottom Card**

### Cardstock:

- Misty Moonlight: 5-1/4 x 4, 2-1/2 square, 3 x 5/8
- Basic White: 8-1/2 x 5-1/2 and scrap for birdhouse trim, bird and greeting
- Early Espresso: 3-1/4 x 2-1/2
- Petal Pink and Granny Apple Green: scrap Country Woods patterned paper: 5-1/8 x 3-7/8 Embellishments of your choice

Fold Basic White cardstock on score line and place fold on left. Adhere Misty Moonlight on card front and then Country Lace paper on top.

Die-cut the birdhouse and trim from Early Espresso. Die cut the birdhouse roof and base from Misty Moonlight. Emboss all these with the Timber 3D folder. Die-cut the birdhouse scalloped trim from Basic White. Punch a ¾" hole in the birdhouse. Adhere the trim and base to the birdhouse with liquid glue and then adhere the entire thing to the card front with Dimensionals.

Die-cut leaves from Granny Apple Green cardstock and the flowers from Petal Pink cardstock and adhere them as shown. With black ink, stamp the bird image on white cardstock and color with Blending Brushes. Die-cut and adhere to the bird house.

Using black ink, stamp a greeting on the scrap of white cardstock. Trim to a banner shape and adhere to the card front.

Add embellishments to the centers of the flowers.
