

## **ABSTRACT**

*The issue of nurse performance continues to be a topic of frequent discussion in various countries. Nurse performance also attracts attention in developing countries, including Indonesia. 2020-2024. The clinical performance of nurses is influenced by internal and external factors. Internal factors include the skills and motivation of nurses, while external factors include supervision, leadership, and monitoring. The purpose of this study was to determine the effect of supervision by the head of medical services and the performance of inpatient nurses on patient safety at the Aek Kanopan Regional General Hospital in North Labuhanbatu in 2026. The study used a cross-sectional design, where the independent and dependent variables were identified at the same time. The study was conducted at the Aek Kanopan Regional General Hospital. The researcher used probability sampling, with a sample size of 120 people. The results of the study showed that there was a significant influence between the supervision of the ward head and patient safety at the Aek Kanopan Regional General Hospital. There is a significant influence between nurse performance and patient safety at Aek Kanopan Hospital. It is hoped that the hospital director will cooperate in building a network to improve health services at the hospital, as hospitals are primary services that are the main step in implementing health efforts.*
