1. 1 Background of the Study

1. 6 Review of Literature

A. Writing

Writing is one of the skills in English. In writing, we must pay attention to word choice, grammar, and tenses to make our writing better. Writing as a process of expressing ideas in words. Harmer (2000: 33) says that writing activities are used to help students carry out various types of writing activities that students need to be able to write to do these activities. Meyers (2005: 2) says that writing is an act or process of finding and organizing ideas, putting them on paper, reshaping, and revising them.

B. Narrative Text

Narrative text can be imaginary or factual. Genre of Narrative texts: Fairy tales, Mysteries, horror, fables, myths, legends, history, personal experiences. Narrative text is an imaginary, non-fictional text used to entertain readers. Narrative text is a text in English that tells a story that has a chronological sequence of events that are interconnected. The characteristics of narrative text use action verbs in the form of past tenses, use a specific noun for a pronoun, use adjectives that form a noun phrase. Use the conjunction to sequence events. According to Derewianka (2004;40) Generic structure of narrative text:

- 1. **Orientation**: Orientation or so called introduction, contains about who, when, where a story is set.
- 2. **Complication**: Complication tells the beginning of the problem that causes the peak of the problem or what is commonly called the climax. This section usually involves the main character of the story.
- 3. **Resolution**: This section is the end of the story, in this section there is a settlement that makes the storyline end.
- 4. **Re-orientation**: The part is the closing of a story which is optional. This part closing sentence that tells the final condition of the moral message of the story.

C. Media

Media is a tool or material used by a teacher in learning. Media are very important. There are many media used in teaching narrative text, including short videos. Stemplesky (1990: 4) says that video can be used at any level, both as a complementary material for language strengthening and skill practice and as a major component of an intensive course.

Edge, Julian (1993: 58) said that video provides information to the eyes and ears, so that students can see communication in action.
