CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background

As an international language, English is very important for students to learn in every school, this is because English has a role to support students' careers in the future. To support English language skills, students must be able to master some basic skills in English, namely reading, writing, speaking, and listening. Listening is one of the English skills that must be mastered by students because it is one of the important instruments in shaping students' character.

CHAPTER II

LITERATURE REVIEW

2.1 Theoretical Framework

In the following, the researcher reviews the theories that underlie this research, such as listening, teaching strategies, and online learning.

A. Listening

Listening is a listening activity and responding to what people say another and then reveal again what is understood from what is said another according to (Octaviyantari, Suarni, & Widiana, 2020). While listening is an activity of understanding in listening to English either directly or using media such as audio and video.

(Bozorgain, 2012) Then in listening there are types of listening, namely content listening, empathic listening, critical listening. Besides that, there is also a process of listening, which is receiving, attending, and responding.

B. Teaching Strategies

Teaching strategies are a condition created by the teacher with the aim that students can follow the learning well as expected by the teacher in achieving the learning objectives set. (Kistner & Rakoczy, 2015) explained that teaching strategy is one of the important aspects that is claimed consistently promotion of independent learning in the classroom. This study investigates the role of instructional context and teacher beliefs for teacher promotion of learning strategies.

According to (Donné, Fraser, & Bousquet, 2016) there are three teaching strategies are active learning strategies, cognitive activation strategies, and teacher-directed instruction strategies.

C. Online Learning

Definition of online learning, online learning is a teaching and learning process carried out from a device that has a network to connect or is commonly referred to as the internet network. Tools that can access the internet are laptops, computers, and smartphones. According to (Adebo, 2018) Online learning is for those who want to study for a degree in addition to a job or other commitment. Online learning has been referred to as a form of distance education and as web-based learning, e-learning, and digital learning. It is offered over the Internet and uses web-based materials and activities.

(Setiawardhani, 2013) thinks Online learning has benefits for both students and instructors. It offers time and space convenience, cost-effectiveness, and flexibility. Online learning allows students to pursue an internationally recognized degree without the need to attend on-campus classes. Online education is preferred by students who cannot participate in traditional classroom settings. It is very convenient because it allows one to study anywhere that has Internet access.
