Writing is a skill that can be developed and learned, according to Djuharie (2005: 120). In today's era, it isn't surprising that many stories or films tell about fictional things such as fairies, mermaids, witches, and so on. According to Barli Bram (2002: 7), writing entails attempting to construct or replicate a written message.

This is the result of the author's idea who succeeded in developing his/her imagination which he then poured into writing. According to McCrimmon in St. Y. Slamet (2008: 141), writing is a way to examine your thoughts and feelings about a subject, decide what to write about, and figure out how to write it so that readers can easily and clearly grasp it.

In writing at the middle school level, the teacher acts as a subject in making lesson plansand also composes teaching programs, so that the learning process carried out can beformed effectively and efficiently. Teachers must pay attention to issues like the goals of teaching writing, establishing assessments that fit within the parameters of teaching writing, and preparing evaluations based on the active participation of students in the learning process.

In middle school, the position of writing in English language skills is important, because writing is one of the 4 branches of total learning in English. Therefore, learning writing in secondary schools must also be adjusted to their respective levels.

Teachers also play an active role in sorting out what methods will be suitable for teaching writing at the secondary level.
