## **ABSTRACT**

Through the various types of content they access, students can practice writing in English in informal and formal contexts, which allows them to develop better writing skills. Although there are variations in how students use social media, all students showed improvements in their writing skills, especially in terms of sentence structure and the use of more varied vocabulary.
