

# **PERILAKU AGRESIF DITINJAU DARI KETERLIBATAN AYAH PADA REMAJA YANG SEDANG MENJALANI HUKUMAN DI LPKA KELAS I MEDAN**

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## **INTISARI**

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui hubungan antara keterlibatan ayah terhadap perilaku agresif. Peneliti menetapkan sampel dalam penelitian ini sebanyak 150 remaja di Lembaga Pembinaan Khusus Anak (LPKA) Kelas I Medan dengan menerapkan teknik *total sampling*. Instrumen yang digunakan berupa skala perilaku agresif dan keterlibatan ayah masing-masing terdiri dari 37 dan 42 aitem. Pendekatan metode korelasi *Pearson Product Moment* digunakan untuk menganalisis data. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa terdapat hubungan negatif yang signifikan antara keterlibatan ayah dan perilaku agresif. Nilai koefisien korelasi sebesar -0,622 dengan signifikansi 0,000 ( $p < 0,05$ ) mengindikasikan bahwa semakin tinggi keterlibatan ayah, maka semakin rendah tingkat perilaku agresif pada remaja. Dengan demikian, dapat disimpulkan bahwa terdapat korelasi antara keterlibatan ayah dan perilaku agresif. Adapun sumbangan efektif keterlibatan ayah terhadap perilaku agresif dengan R squared sebesar 0,387 yang artinya peningkatan keterlibatan ayah berkontribusi terhadap penurunan perilaku agresif. Dengan demikian, keterlibatan ayah memberikan sumbangan sebesar 38,7% terhadap tingkat perilaku agresif dan 61,3% dipengaruhi oleh faktor lain.

***AGGRESSIVE BEHAVIOR SEEN FROM FATHER INVOLVEMENT IN  
ADOLESCENTS UNDERGOING PUNISHMENT AT CLASS I MEDAN  
JUVENILE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY***

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**ABSTRACT**

*This study aims to determine the relationship between father involvement and aggressive behavior. The researcher set the sample in this study at 150 adolescents in the Class I Special Child Guidance Institution (LPKA) in Medan by applying the total sampling technique. The instruments used were aggressive behavior and father involvement scales, consisting of 37 and 42 items, respectively. The Pearson Product Moment correlation method was used to analyze the data. Based on the results of the study, there was a negative relationship between father involvement and aggressive behavior, with a significant correlation of -0.622 and a significance value of 0.000 ( $p < 0.05$ ). The findings of this study suggest that increased father involvement corresponds to lower levels of aggression among adolescents, whereas reduced involvement tends to elevate aggressive behavior. The effective contribution of father involvement to higher aggression levels. The extent to which father involvement contributes effectively to this relationship, the higher the level of aggressive behavior in adolescents. The effective contribution of father involvement to aggressive behavior is R squared of 0.387, which means that an increase in father involvement contributes to a decrease in aggressive behavior. Thus, father involvement contributes 38.7% to the level of aggressive behavior, while 61.3% is influenced by other factors.*
