# Village to consider speed limits for e-bikes

Bolivar Mayor Tedd Finlayson told council members during the November meeting he has received a number of complaints about e-bikes traveling at high speed on the Towpath Trail through town. He asked council to consider setting speed limits on the portions of the trail that go through Bolivar.

Finlayson said Ohio uses a three-tiered classification for e-bikes and that the bikes are permitted to use the trail, even though other motorized vehicles are not. He said Class 1 and Class 2 bikes, according to federal guidelines, both have maximum speeds of 20 mph while Class 3 bikes can travel at speeds up to 28 mph.

The potential danger is apparent as many people use the trails for walking, running and exercising their pets. Council is to take the matter under advisement.

Finlayson also reported the resignation of fiscal officer Barb Kline, effective Monday, Oct. 30. Council accepted the resignation. Patty Smith has agreed to step in as interim fiscal officer until a permanent replacement can be found.

Council approved contracting with Smith at \$30 per hour for up to 40 hours per week, with Smith agreeing to help train her replacement at the rate of \$20 per hour.

Discussion of pay raises for council members was tabled until next month.

#### Police department matters

During the public comments portion of the meeting, a resident said he has heard several rumors the village is considering eliminating its police department and relying solely on the county sheriff's department. The rumor was put to rest with Finlayson saying the village is looking to hire additional personnel.

In related matters Bruce Lawver, safety committee chair, said village officers have been recertified through the State of Ohio, with all units qualifying with their duty weapons. Lawver said the cruiser radars also have been tested and certified for one year.

Finance chair Will Bellinger said the village is continuing to lose money on trash pickup, and with Kimble planning an increase next year due to the cost of the fuel, he would like council to consider raising trash pickup rates for residents by 50 cents per month to properly fund refuse pickup.

In a related matter, Finlayson said he had spoken to officials in Zoar regarding the need to raise the cost of the protection provided by the Bolivar Police Department to cover losses being incurred. He said he received approval to raise the rate from \$28 to \$34 per hour.

#### Discussion of Bolivar Intermediate School property

Bolivar resident Steve Pancoe asked council about plans for the property where the intermediate school will be torn down. Pancoe said he and his wife support a park and walking trails.

Finlayson said the village is not yet in possession of the property but is welcoming ideas from residents about what should be done with the site. Council member Maria App further advised Pancoe that the village plans to hold focus

groups to determine how to use the property and invited Pancoe and other residents to get involved.

Further discussion centered on what, if any, playground equipment can be saved, with council to look into insurance regulations and other influencing factors.

#### Approvals by council

In addition to approving a request for \$3,400 for trees that need taken down, council approved entering into contracts with GPD for engineering services related to waterline upgrades and with Gueye & Associates and the Ohio Auditor of State for the purpose of state audits.

Council heard the following proposed legislation measures:

—First reading of a resolution allowing the mayor to appoint a member of council to the Bolivar Bicentennial Committee.

—Second reading of a measure to approve contracting with the Tuscarawas County Public Defender's Office for indigent defense services for 2024.

Before adjourning, council met in executive session as requested by attorney Stephan Babik to discuss pending or imminent litigation.

Bolivar Council meets the first Thursday of each month at 7 p.m. at Village Hall. All meetings are open to the public.

# Fort Laurens to commemorate 245th anniversary Nov. 18

On Nov. 18, 1778, 1,200 continental soldiers fighting for independence from England arrived at a site just outside Bolivar with a mission: to build a fort that would constitute a staging area for an attack on British troops at Fort Detroit.

In partnership with the Brigade of the American Revolution, Fort Laurens Museum invites the public to a free event commemorating that day on Saturday, Nov. 18 from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Starting just north of Bolivar, living historians in period dress will march to the site where they would build the fort named for Henry Laurens, then president of the Continental Congress, on the western bank of the Tuscarawas River.

Visitors can greet the soldiers as they march in at around 10 a.m. to perform a ceremony at the Tomb of the Unknown Patriot, the

final resting place for one of the soldiers who could not be identified.

Historical demonstrations on 18th-century weaponry, tools and other aspects of military camp life will take place throughout the day.

"The living historians are there to interact with the public and share the history of the park to give visitors a better understanding of what happened on that day," said Tanner Immel, site manager of Fort Laurens. "I think it's important for people to actually see history. We want them to recognize the conditions the soldiers faced by putting people in their shoes and taking them back to that time period and frame of mind."

In addition to building a fort, soldiers were charged with deterring Americans allied with the British from conducting raids against settlers in Eastern Ohio and Western Pennsylvania. A third purpose for the fort was to protect the area's

neutral Delaware Indians and convince them to join the American cause.

## Museum tours and gift shop

The Fort Laurens Museum will be open that day with guided and self-guided tours available for \$5 per person. Visitors can view a video presentation and artifacts bearing witness to the fort's history and eventual abandonment after attacks by both British troops and local American Indian tribes, unforgivably harsh weather, and a desperate lack of food would combine

to bring about the death of 30 soldiers, 21 of which are interred in the onsite cemetery.

The museum gift shop will hold a sale on commemorative merchandise from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. "We kind of specialize in historic books on the Revolutionary

War and 18th-century life," Immel said.

The store also sells a variety of merchandise ranging from coffee mugs and T-shirts to period toys and children's books. "It's a good opportunity to purchase some special holiday gifts," Immel said.

Immel hopes those who attend will discover the importance of Fort Laurens and its place in American history.

"This is the site of an actual Revolutionary War fort built by American soldiers, approved by the Continental Congress and signed off by Gen. Washington," he said. "It is also one of the only forts built by soldiers outside of the 13 colonies in an area that would later be referred to as a stepping stone for westward movement."

Dorothy Belles celebrated her 100th birthday

orothy Belles celebrated her 100th birthday on Oct. 31 with children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren on hand to mark the milestone at Hennis Care Center of Bolivar, where she is a resident. Of a lifetime spanning a century, Belles said, "The Lord has been good to me. I'm doing good."

She credits her longevity to having remained active and engaged, and she answers most questions with a small joke, still cracking wise at 100. "I always liked to stay active and busy," she

The centenarian takes the changes that have occurred in the world during her lifetime since 1923 in stride. "So many things have changed," she said. "People have changed. Well, all of life is about change. It has to change. It's amazing the things that happen in life before you finally get another one."

She previously worked for a time at J.C. Penney, where she said she mostly liked to ride the elevator. "I think I worked there before I was married, riding the elevator. 'If you want to go up or you want to go down, you'd better behave or I'll turn you down," she said, remembering her rhyme from that time and adding, "You're asking me a lot of questions."

Belles remembers her family had Fords when she was young. "My dad was a Ford man, not the old Fords, but the new ones. I think maybe there was a Plymouth at one time or another," she said.

In raising her children, she said her fondest memories are of keeping them busy so they were happy. "They were good kids, three boys and a girl. I don't think they were too bad. Three boys, that's tough, you know? But they were always pretty good," she said.

She said she had a good time with the birthday celebrations. "We had a wonderful time," she said, turning to Beth Wade, unit manager at Hennis Care Center, who was assisting her. "How many were there, do you know?"

"Well, today, you had about 20 visitors," Wade said. "But at your other party in Louisville the other day, there were more like 30 people." This brought a smile to Belles' face.

Asked if she'd been married, the twinkle in her eye renewed. "Not yet." She turned again to Wade. "Am I married?"

"No," Wade said. "Well, yes, she was."

A followup question about children brought another jibe. 'Why do you ask such a dumb question? I'm not married yet," she said.

Then the question about where she might have worked brought this reply: "Why would I work? Didn't I have a husband?" She clearly relished keeping her companions on their toes.

Wade reminded Belles of her four children. "Yes, I had four children with my first husband."

Asked if she had any special memories of life at home as a youngster, she said, "My mom was a good cook. Everybody ate pretty much everything Mom made. I can't remember anything specific." She looked over her shoulder. "Hey Mom, where are you? Help me remember."

Her day included an early visit from family, then a lunch shared with fellow Hennis residents. The facility was decorated in her honor, and there was a cake.

Wade said Belles remains alert and engaged with the world around her. "I'm still busy around here," Belles said. "I guess I'm pretty fortunate."

# Helping cats that live outside

For Lindsay Bailey of New Philadelphia, it began when her cat Tiger went missing two years ago. Today, she builds shelters for feral cats and makes sure dozens are fed every day. She wasn't always a cat person, however.

"I didn't realize there was this feral cat population out there until then," Bailey said. "People would spot a cat and call me and say, 'This looks like Tiger,' and I'd go see. Every time I went, there were tons of cats everywhere. I started out feeding them, and now I probably feed 50 or 60 cats every day.'

Bailey soon realized the cats she was feeding had no way of sheltering themselves, and the idea to provide shelters was born.

"I reached out to a woman in Massillon who was able to get me some coolers. Her company uses and discards them constantly," she said.

Bailey drives to pick up a new supply of coolers each week. She uses cash donations to fund the neutering of trapped cats, cat food and veterinary care.

The coolers are standard picnic models and a few Styrofoam shipping coolers. Bailey peels off any stickers she finds, washes the coolers thoroughly, makes a kitty-

sized hole in the side, fills it another eight kittens being with straw and seals the lid on with strong tape. She then distributes the shelters to anyone who needs one from her home.

In addition to sheltering and feeding feral cats, Bailey also traps them and has them neutered before returning them to the spot where they were found. It's part of the "trap, neuter, release" strategy for reducing feral cat populations.

'Many people don't understand how that works," Bailey said. "They believe that if you just don't feed them, the problem will go away. That's not the case. Actively neutering cats and putting them back out there is the only thing that reduces the overall population. You start with a colony. Then once that colony is all fixed, the problem dies down and you move on to another."

She makes a couple of trips a week to either Alter-Clinic or Humble Creatures, both in Canton, to have cats neutered. "I've probably fixed around 40 cats in the last year and a half, and I've found homes for about half of those," she said.

She helps those who have cats but are unable to afford vet care for neutering as well. "I'd rather use some of the money I have from donations for that than see added to the population, she said.

She hasn't always been a cat person. "Believe it or not, I didn't used to care for cats," she said. "Then I got one and fell in love with her and then another.'

The total in her direct care currently stands at seven.

She tells those who take her shelters to check them frequently to see if they're damp.

"You have to stick your hand in under the straw to check because you never know what kind of burrowing a cat does. Some just pile all the straw up in front of the opening to block it. The straw usually needs changed every couple of months depending on the weather," she said. "I've seen some tough situations. It's a rewarding job but also bittersweet. I don't like seeing some of the distressing situations, but if I don't do this, no one will."



# Subsurface field tile maintenance

#### By District Technician Dylan Stine

Now that most crops are coming off fields everywhere, it is a good time to begin field tile maintenance and repairs. Before planting crops in the spring is another good time to check your tile lines. You also can check them during or right after a large rain event. This will give you the best picture of what is happening.

If tile lines are checked, maintained and repaired correctly, it will last its life expectancy or even outlive it. I've made several field visits to look at wet spots or blowouts in fields and discovered it is still old clay tile. If I had to bet, I'd say that farmer or the ones



prior to always checked and maintained their lines, inlets, outlets and junction boxes.

Many of these checks are done visually, not by driving by, but by getting out and walking the fields looking at inlets and outlets. Look for wet spots, holes, erosion along a line or even small seeps.

—One quick and easy way for tile lines to become plugged is from rodents crawling up into the outlets because a rodent guard was

not installed.

—Remove all trash and debris buildup at the inlets and outlets.

—Keep woody vegetation at least 5 feet away from the outlets.

—Remove trees such as willows, cotton woods, elm and soft maples from the surrounding area of subsurface drains. These types of trees will seek water and can get into the tile and break it or plug it up.

—Maintain a splash pad of Class C Rip Rap at the outlet to reduce erosion.


—Look for settling where the lines were installed to maintain 24 inches of cover over the subsurface drains. Driving heavy equipment over settled areas can crush the pipe.

Another very important thing to have is tile blocks or temporary flowblocking devices if the tile lines become polluted from land application of manure. Make sure to maintain setbacks from inlets or waterways while applying manure. Avoid applying manure while the soil is saturated and the tiles are already flowing water. This also will alleviate the chance for compaction and potentially crushing the pipe. If working in an area where iron ochre is present in the soil, install a clean-out structure to provide access for cleaning equipment.




