### More testing needed to continue work on levee

A second soil test is being conducted and an additional internal erosion interception trench is being built before work can continue on the Zoar Levee. Nathan White, archaeologist for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, updated stakeholders about progress on the levee in an online update meeting on March 31.

White said the new test will determine the proper cement mix — slurry — to be used as backfill in the construction of the IEIT. The trench is part of a system being installed by the corps, which includes relief wells and piping designed to prevent erosion and water seepage under the levee.

This is the second time around for testing the slurry mix after additional verification borings yielded the same results as the first test. According to White, the contractor removed soils from the site and performed mix design testing in the lab. However. results in the lab don't always correlate to the field.

"They've gone back to the drawing board with the slurry, and they believe that they've come up with the right mix this time," White said. "They're in the process of putting that in the ground now, and, of course, the production

phase of the IEIT will not commence until they have approved that slurry."

White said the contractor has made improvements to their methods based on the results of the original demonstration section to ensure the replacement demonstration section meets specifications.

According to White, additional work on the relief wells took place the week of March 28. New relief wells were installed in 2020 and 2021 to collect water seepage and convey it to a ponding area to relieve the build-up of pressure caused by underground water build-up in the aquifer.

Zoar is open for business

Historic Zoar Village and its museums officially opened for the season on April 2. White said the corps wants people to know Zoar is open for business and that people can visit with as few interruptions as possible.

"We won't be taking part in any activities that will make a lot of noise," White said, when work coincides with the site's hours. "We will be setting up a kiosk to explain to visitors what the fuss is all about."

In order to stay on schedule, White said some weekend work will be necessary, but the corps will do its best not to conflict with events taking place in Zoar.

The repair work is in response to flood water leeching under the levee, which began during the flood of 2005, indicating the possibility of future levee failure.

While the official groundbreaking for the project took place in August 2020, work has been delayed due to the pandemic and the discovery of artifacts and anomalies during preconstruction work.

The fact that Zoar is a National Historic Landmark means extra time and care must be taken during every step of the construction process. The National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, Section 106 requires that federally assisted projects consider possible effects on historic properties before work can begin.

In addition to the village's historic museums, most of the homes were built in the 1800s, which also means extra care is required to avoid damage caused by vibrations from equipment.

The estimated \$13 million project involves input and buy-in from a number of organizations including the National Park Service, Ohio History Connection, Ohio State Historic Preservation Office, Ohio Archaeological Council, Ohio & Erie Canalway Coalitions, Seneca Nation of Indians and the Zoar Community Association.

### Recycle: Don't trash outdated electronics

The Navarre-Bethlehem Park is taking old electronics and recycling them through a new program implemented by the Bethlehem Township trustees. A recycling bin has been placed in the park for people to deposit any electronics that will fit into it.

"We accept old computers, printers, chargers, hair drvers, curling irons, string lights, kitchen appliances, microwaves, televisions, computer monitors, batteries and more," said T. Reneé Veselenak, a newly elected township trustee who spearheaded the program.

Veselenak said she got the idea for placing a bin in the park for electronic waste, also known as e-waste, when she saw a television in the

cardboard recycling bin in mercury, cadmium and arsedowntown Navarre. "So I just started wondering, how do people get rid of all these electronics?

At a Stark County Trustee Association meeting, Veselenak talked to someone from a neighboring township who had just implemented an e-waste recycling program and was happy to offer advice. Veselenak pitched the idea at the next Bethlehem Township trustees meeting and got the green light to start a program.

### Why it's needed

Improperly disposing of e-waste into landfills can pollute ecosystems for many years to come as toxic chemicals leech into the soil. Ultimately, chemicals like lead,


nic also can impact air and water quality, posing serious threats to human health.

According to the Global E-Waste Statistics Partnership, the volume of e-waste grew by 21% between 2015 and 2019, creating 53.6 million metric tons of waste. Yet only a little more than 17% of e-waste generated in 2019 was recycled.

### How to recycle e-waste

Veselenak is encouraging residents to place all of their old electronics in the bin at the park. "We're working with a company called Summit E-Waste out of Akron, so for items that won't fit in the bin - like larger televisions and large home appliances — peo-

Every 'I love you' means more for exchange student from Ukraine

In many ways Anastasia Didenko is a typical teenager. She is a cheerleader, she listens to Lana del Rey and her favorite food is chocolate ice cream. She even participated in Academic Challenge last fall.

What's not typical about Didenko is the situation in which she finds herself, especially as a 17-year-old. Didenko came from Ukraine to the U.S. as an exchange student in September 2021. She attends Tuscarawas Central Catholic High School and lives in Bolivar with her host parents, Heather Jones and Bobby Eddy.

Didenko needs every ounce of her seemingly unbreakable spirit right now as she remains in the U.S. while her family is nearly 6,000 miles away. She does not know if she will be able to go home in late May as she was supposed to.

Her mother Julia, 12-year-old sister Veronika and 4-year-old Pomeranian dog Genny safely escaped to Poland early in the war. However, Didenko's father Dmydro must remain at home to fight if any of the battles come close to her hometown of Novomoskovsk, a city of around 70,000 people in Eastern Ukraine.


Didenko came to the U.S. as an exchange student because she not only wanted to see America, but also because she wanted to teach others about Ukraine and its culture.

"Since everything that's happened, people are more educated," she said. "Before that, people didn't really even know where Ukraine is — that it's not a part of Russia or anything. It's not, and it will never be."

Didenko recalled the night she learned the country was under attack. "I was checking my phone for news and messages when I first learned that explosions had been heard," she said. "I didn't believe it. The first time I called my dad, he said, 'Hey, it's fine. We were sleeping. Nothing happened. No one heard anything. Go to bed.' But then about 30 minutes later, they heard it too."

Complicating matters, Didenko's mother was in a different city from her father and sister. "I was so worried that something would happen to them," she said. "The first week was the worst. I didn't want to do anything. I didn't sleep. I didn't want to eat."

Didenko reached out to her classmates, teachers and the administration at Central Catholic for support. "I went to school, and I was still in

this state of mind where I'm lost. I felt helpless, but I decided I need to do something. So I went to my principal, and then I talked to students and we started a fundraiser," she said.

### **Taking action helps**

Didenko said taking action is what helps her deal with the unimaginable. "I can't just sit and cry, or nothing would change," she said.

The teenager is simultaneously keeping up with school work, school activities, volunteering in Zoar and dealing with the horror of war.

"I'm still keeping up with what's going on, but I mean I have a life too," she said. "It was hard to understand that I can't just sit and read the news all the time and not be here. I need to be here too, so I can do more and help more than if I would just sit and be upset."

Jones said she and Eddy try their best to help Didenko. "Sometimes we don't know everything that's bothering her, so we don't know what to do," she said. "We've obviously never been in this situation before."

The couple have not yet raised children of their own, let alone a teenager whose country is at war. Jones said the school has been incredibly supportive, and they are grateful.

"It has to be so hard to be away from your parents, even under normal circumstances," Jones said. "We try to stay active. We had a campfire and made s'mores, went sled riding, we watch movies, and right now we're working on a huge puzzle of Hogwarts."

#### What comes next

Didenko was scheduled to return to Ukraine at the end of May. Now everything is up in the air. "Things change every 15 minutes," she said.

She is likely to be able to graduate high school, although at one point that was even in question. Her studies here do not count toward her graduation in Ukraine, so she is simultaneously doing her senior year of Ukrainian school online.

Hard work and involvement with other activities help, she said. Still, it hurts her to see her homeland being attacked. "It's just terrible," she said. "It's not just a war; it's genocide."

When asked what Ukraine is like during peaceful times, Didenko said, "Honestly, I love my country, and I love our people. Everyone is just so sincere and open. It feels so warm. No matter to what city you go, people will be happy to see you. People will welcome you. We have a very deep history. It's very bloody. We have been fighting for independence for centuries."

I look forward to the day when my friends no longer have to text me to let me know they are still alive or my parents have to hang up because the air raid sirens threaten another bombing."

Didenko is begging Americans not to forget about the war. "People are forgetting about it, and I don't want this to happen because it's still going on and it's getting worse. I see the horrors and think, 'It could be me or one of my friends.' And it has been."

Didenko said an entire family of one of her classmates was killed, and she has lost touch with many others. "I don't know what has happened to them," she said. "I just want people to know what is really going on. I'm happy that I'm here right now so people can see through my perspective and I can share what I think and what is actually going on."

In the meantime Didenko listens to songs by her favorite Ukrainian artist, Luna. "I really liked her music for quite a long time," she said. "Right now I like her even more because of her position on the war. She does the right thing, and she has beautiful music."

### How to help

Monetary donations can be dropped off at the Central Catholic High School office or at Lock 7 Hair Studio in Bolivar. Contributions also can be mailed to the salon at 10880 state Route 212 NE with checks made payable to Lock 7 Hair Studio.

"Money is the best thing right now, as it is too expensive to send material items," said Didenko, who has raised about \$5,000 so far. "Every dollar can help right now."

"I do not know when this will be over," Didenko said in her essay. "I do not know when I will hug my mom — I do not know if my conversation with my dad is the last one because he so courageously is protecting my home. I do not know what will happen in the next 15 minutes, but I know that no matter what, I will keep moving and stay strong — for my dad, my mom and my country. I know I will fight until the end, no matter how hurt or powerless I feel. This is who I am."

Veselenak said she is hoping to plan a community drop-off day when a Summit E-Waste truck can pull into town and people can dispose of those larger items.

"The good thing about Summit E-Waste is they can take anything from a fan to a curling iron," Veselenak said. "They completely strip it down to minimal waste, and everything that comes out of it, the copper and other materials, is used to make new electronics. So it's completely recycled."

### **Recycling generates** funds for the park

Veselenak said the recycling program will actually generate funds for the park. We are actually receiving funding from this," she said. "My main was just to find a way that we could take all those things laying around the house and get them to where they're supposed to be. But we are also getting money for each pound of e-waste, and we will be able to put that into buying extra things for the park without having to use tax dollars."

The co-owner of Main Street Deli and Baking Company in Navarre, Veselenak said she ran for the trustee position to give back to the community. "My business is established now after 15 years, so I have time now, and I love it. I love the people here, so helping to solve their problems is fun for me."

Veselenak believes educating others about the need for electronic recycling is critical. "I'm planning to talk to the SilverSneakers group at our local YMCA and hope to talk to the kids there as well," she said. "I'd also like to go into our public schools to educate people about electronic recycling."

Plastics account for 25-30% of the end-of-life electronics stream. They pose a significant impediment to recycling efforts as they must be processed, which can offset the value of other materials extracted. Previously, 99% of the work was outsourced to China. Today, the large volumes of plastic must be dealt with locally. This means that much of it ends up in landfills or getting burned because there are no resources in place

### Fast fashion can come at a cost

Economically, fast fashion is beneficial to consumers; however, most clothes produced this way end up

in landfills after they break down within a few washes due to the cheap quality. Although fast fashion might make shopping for clothes more affordable, it comes at an environmental and even

social cost.

The fashion industry consumes one-tenth of all the water used industrially to run factories and clean products, making it the second-largest waterconsuming industry. Based on a report by CNBC, "Just one pair of regular jeans requires 3,625 liters of water, the same amount of water one person requires for basic survival for around 2.5 years."

In addition to the amount of water used, the synthetic material used for the clothes contains plastic microfibers, contributing to the 35% that winds up polluting oceans, according to a study made at Princeton University.

The same study found more than 60% of fabric fibers are now synthetic, derived from fossil fuels, so when clothing ends up in a landfill, about 85% of textile waste in the United States goes to landfills or is incinerated. It will not decay.





### **AFib: A common heart** problem often ignored

Dear Savvy Senior,

What can you tell me about atrial fibrillation? Every so often, I've noticed my heart starts beating rapidly for no particular reason. Is this something I should be worried about?

Anxious Annie Dear Annie,

Heart palpitations can be harmless if they are brief and infrequent. But if you're experiencing an erratic heart rhythm, you need to get checked out by a doctor for atrial fibrillation.

AFib, which is marked by rapid, fluttering beats, can lead to serious complications such as stroke and heart failure, when the weakened heart can't pump enough blood to the rest of the body.

Normally, your heartbeat follows a steady rhythm as your heart contracts and relaxes. But when you have

AFib, the upper chambers of your heart (atria) beat rapidly and irregularly. sending blood to the lower chambers (ventricles) less efficiently. These episodes can last for minutes to hours or longer and can cause palpitations, lightheadedness, fatigue and/or shortness of breath. Over time AFib tends to become chronic.

Age is a common risk factor for AFib, which affects roughly 10% of people older than 75. Other factors include genetics, obesity, diabetes, high blood pressure, and alcohol and tobacco use. The condition also has been linked to viral infections including

COVID-19.

### **Diagnosing AFib**

If vou're experiencing AFib-like symptoms, you need to see your doctor, who will listen to your heart and likely recommend an electrocardiogram or a treadmill heart test, or you may wear a portable monitor for several weeks to look for abnormal heart rhythms to confirm a diagnosis of AFib. Such tests can help distinguish AFib from less serious conditions that may cause the heart to flutter, like anxiety and stress.

AFib affects some 3 million adults in the United States, a number that is expected to quadruple in the coming decade as the population ages and risk factors like obesity, diabetes and high blood pressure become even more common. The

lifetime risk of developing AFib is greater than 20%, yet many people don't even know they have it.

### **Treatment options**

A growing body of research underscores the importance of lifestyle steps such as exercise, a healthy diet and limiting alcohol for treating AFib.

Depending on your age and symptoms, your doctor may prescribe drugs to help control your heart rate, like beta blockers such as metoprolol (Toprol XL) and/or rhythm such as antiarrhythmics like flecainide (Tambocor).

You also may need an electrical cardioversion, an outpatient procedure that delivers an electrical shock to the heart to restore a normal rhythm. You will be sedated for this brief procedure and not feel the shocks.

Catheter ablation is

area of heart tissue that causes irregular heartbeats.
This procedure is becoming more common based on evidence of its safety and ability to normalize the heart rhythm and ease symptoms.
Ablations can be effective in people age 75 and older, but medication may still be required afterward.

If you're at higher risk for stroke, you may be

another outpatient treatment for AFib that scars a small

If you're at higher risk for stroke, you may be prescribed a blood thinner too. In the past, Coumadin (warfarin) was the only such drug widely available, but it requires monitoring with regular blood tests. Newer anticoagulants, like apixaban (Eliquis) and rivaroxaban (Xarelto), don't have that requirement and have been shown to be just as effective at preventing strokes.

### **April brings to mind finances**

Along with warming days and the hope of flowers, April often brings to mind financial issues. Did preparing your taxes get you thinking about your money situation?

What are the expenses looming in your near or not so near future? If you have children, have you started saving or investing to help with their college expenses? Make it a detailed record and review it regularly. You can't make wise decisions without good data.

What bills do you pay monthly? What gets paid quarterly, semi-annually or yearly? Do you put part of the payment up ahead of time or get caught by surprise? Do you have a list of what is due during each month?

Have you written out a budget? Do you compare your actual spending to what you intended to spend? How close are you? If you perpetually go over in an area, what can you do to adjust what you spend in that category?

Do you have a fund for unexpected occurrences? Have you built up an emergency fund? Make a list of expenses that caught you by surprise last year and maybe a year or two before that. Were they really surprises or should you have expected things like car repairs, appliance replacement and dental work?

If you are on top of the regular bill stuff, have you built up some savings or started investing? If you lost your current source of

income, could you support yourself and your family for a few months with what you have saved? Do you have alternate sources of income that could help? What could you do to set up passive forms of income?

Taking stock of the situation and sorting it all out can feel overwhelming, so start with small steps. If you don't currently track your spending, start by writing down everything you spend for a week or a month. Make sure you review the information at the end of the time period. Are you spending in an area more than expected? Seeing the pattern can be the first step in making needed changes.

Get an understanding of your monthly and yearly expenses. How much do you need to set aside each month or pay period so you have what you need when big bills like property taxes come due?

Set goals for the longer-term things. How much could you set aside to help with college expenses? Are you using the retirement savings vehicles available to you? Are you getting the most from them with things like employer matches?

Things may not change quickly, but assessing where you are and deciding where you need to be can get you going in the right direction.


