Attributes of Jesus

#8 and 9 – Love and Forgiveness

Good morning, church family! Starting in January, my goal was to share one attribute of Jesus each month for us to emulate. Well, I dropped the ball in August, so for the month of Septem-

ber I would like for us to focus on two closely related characteristics – Jesus' love and forgiveness.

Even a cursory glance at the gospels reveals that Jesus regularly exhibited both of these important traits. Contrary to what some may think, He didn't come to live a life of comfort and ease. Throughout most of His ministry, the religious elite were constantly trying to trick Him (Matthew 22:15), arrest Him (John 7:30), and even kill Him prior to His crucifixion (Mark 11:18). Not only did it take great restraint and strength of character to keep from retaliating, it took matchless love. After all, it was the Lord who said "Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you" (Matthew 5:44).

Sometimes, we might be tempted to even the score with someone who has wronged us, but this is not Christ-like behavior. We're reminded that after being beaten, flogged, crucified, and mocked as the blood and the life ran out from His body, the Lord prayed for God to forgive His persecutors for their evil deeds.

If Jesus could find it in his heart to love others in spite of their faults, so should we. Perhaps there's someone in your life that has wronged you — or maybe you're the offending party. It's time to make things right by forgiving that person, or by apologizing for something you said or did to injure or discourage them.

James 2:8 says, "If you really fulfill the royal law according to the Scripture, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself,' you are doing well."
