#### **Idle Minds**

At some point, you have probably heard someone say, "An idle mind is the devil's workshop." While you won't find this exact phrase in the Bible, it does contain plenty of illustrations which showcase the destructive power of idleness.

In Proverbs 24:33-34 we read the following:

"A little sleep, a little slumber, a little folding of the hands to rest, and poverty will come upon you like a robber, and want like an armed man."

While it is often easy to detect the physical ramifications of idleness, the toll that it takes on our spiritual lives often flies under the radar; and if not properly dealt with, it can lead to other, more serious, conditions of the heart.

That's why in Philippians 4:8, Paul provided his brethren with a solution to help abate this deadly mentality. He said, "Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things."

Too often, Christians let down their guard, falsely assuming that as long as they pray, attend worship services, and put money in the collection plate, Satan will keep his distance. However, the Scriptures make it clear that when we aren't actively working to produce good fruit, or we aren't intentionally filling our hearts with wholesome, encouraging thoughts, we leave the door open for Satan to set his snares.

In 2021, may we all strive to live purposeful, godly lives.
