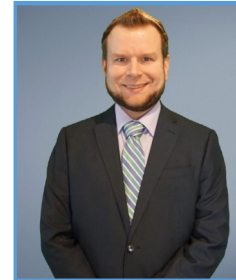

Spiritual Checkup

It has been almost a year since the Covid-19 pandemic made its way to Texas. That means it has been almost a year since we have cancelled Sunday and Wednesday evening services, and almost a year since we have had potlucks or any other fellowship gatherings at our church building.

Whenever our lives are interrupted by something so significant, it is likely to alter our habits. However, it also affords us perfect opportunities to create new routines for ourselves and our families. With that in mind, have you been taking advantage of those opportunities? Is your spiritual health where it ought to be, or have you found yourself suffering from a lack of spiritual nourishment?

If you answered the latter, there are several things that you can do to remedy the situation.

Start a Bible-reading plan. In just 10-15 minutes a day, you can complete the entire Bible in a year.

Watch our Wednesday evening adult class. Since the beginning of the pandemic, I have released a series of classes including both topical and textual studies. These may be accessed through our Facebook page or on YouTube.

Come to our 2 PM service. If you have been hesitant to attend Sunday morning worship out of concern for Covid, our second service is smaller and masks are mandatory.

Regardless of world pandemics or other obstacles that may get in the way, we must remember that we have a responsibility as Christians to seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness. When Christ returns, there will be no time for excuses, so if your relationship with Him is lacking or you find yourself slipping back into patterns of sin, then make the necessary changes while you still can. May we all continue to have a happier and spiritually healthier 2021!
