

COVID-19 Safe Plan

BHFC GRADING PROTOCOLS



No one should attend if in the last 14 days you:

- Have had flu like symptoms.
- Have been in contact with a known or suspected case of COVID-19.
- Attended any of the reported case locations listed on the NSW Health website
- Are at high risk from a health perspective (elderly or pre-existing condition)

Key points

- It is the parent/guardian's responsibility to sign in with the BHFC QR code. Multiple copies of the code will be available at all fields and on all tables to maintain social distancing and limit people gathering at a central location to sign in.
- Sanitise as soon as you arrive at your field.
- The changing rooms will be closed to all participants.
- Players are to arrive dressed to grade. Shin pads and boots are compulsory.
- Only players and officials are permitted to access the field.
- Players' bags and drinks are to be kept with their parent/guardian at all times.
- No handshakes or high fives
- No spitting
- No sharing of water bottles
- DO NOT mix with any other grading age group.
- Spectators and players to always observe social distancing. (Except when grading).
- Leave immediately after grading has concluded.

Spectators

- Juniors are restricted to one adult spectator per player.
- All parents must remain behind the field fencing during grading.
- Social distance at all times from others that are not in your immediate family.
- Face masks are not compulsory. If you want to wear one that's fine but a mask does not replace any other social distancing or sickness protocol outlined herein.
- 1 person at a time in all toilets, and ensure hands are washed after use.

Procedure

- Go straight to the field on which your grading session is being undertaken.
- Use hand sanitiser at the table.
- Have player name together with contact name and contact phone number recorded on the sign in sheet.
- Grading number will be written on player's arm. IMPORTANT. Please remember this number and make sure it is the only number you use during the entire 3 weeks of grading.

IMPORTANT: You must be socially distanced when signing in. Do not touch the sign in sheets, someone will do that for you. Minimise all unnecessary contact.

- Players stay on the field and follow graders directions.
- Players should not take bags or drinks onto the field. Leave all your belongings with your parent so there is no unnecessary mix up of clothing or drinks etc.
Older players who have no parent in attendance: please separate your bags and keep all belongings in your clearly identified bag at the edge of the field.
