

Dear Del Mar Schools Volunteer,

We are starting a new school year, and parent and community volunteers are an important part of our schools. The administration, teachers and staff all appreciate the priceless gift of your time. There are many opportunities to volunteer in our schools. You will hear more about the date for signing up for these volunteer opportunities sometime in September.

State law requires that all school personnel and volunteers have proof of a current TB test on file. If you do not have proof of a TB test done within the last four years, please plan to get your skin test done prior to the volunteer sign-up day. You will not be allowed to volunteer unless your skin test is current.

Skin tests are available for \$11.00 through the San Diego County Department of Public Health. The local clinic operates on the second Tuesday of every month between 3:00 - 5:30 p.m. at the Solana Beach Presbyterian Church, 120 Stevens Street in Solana Beach. It is located in Debin Hall, Room 15C, on the first floor of the new building. Please submit a copy of your test to the volunteer coordinator at your school. These test results are valid for four years.

We look forward to your participation in your child's education, and we appreciate your cooperation in this manner. If you have any questions, please contact the nurse at your school.
