Subject: Relationship of DMUSD and DMSEF

During the past few months, several members of the community have expressed concerns about several aspects of the Del Mar Schools Education Foundation, an independent tax-exempt 501c(3) public benefit corporation that was created by DMUSD parents/community to advance the cause of K-6 public education for students who are enrolled in the Del Mar Union School District.

On October 17, the Board of Directors of the Del Mar Schools Education Foundation (DMSEF) decided to ask an outside review team to conduct a study of current DMSEF practices and procedures to make certain that the DMSEF is using "best practices" as it operates as a non-profit public benefit corporation whose mission is to advance the cause of K-6 public education for students who are enrolled in the Del Mar Union School District.

Tonight District staff is planning to provide information that will answer several questions about the relationship of the DMUSD and the DMSEF, including:

1. What is the nature of the District's involvement with the DMSEF? How is the DMUSD engaged with DMSEF?
2. What support does the DMUSD provide to the DMSEF, an independent tax-exempt 501c(3) public benefit corporation?
3. How did it occur that a portion of the annual DMSEF goals are targeted at individual school levels?
