Subject: Update, 2008/2009 Enrollment and Staffing Projections

Following this narrative are the staffing and enrollment projections for the 2008/2009 school year. There are a few modifications incorporated into this projection that are different from the previous projections shared at previous Board meetings. The differences include:

1. removing a kindergarten and a first grade section from Del Mar Heights (due to the Board's decision to postpone implementation of the Spanish Discovery program)
2. an additional kindergarten section at Ocean Air
3. an additional kindergarten section at Sycamore Ridge
4. changing a blended class at Sycamore Ridge from 1/2 to a 2/3 blend

The staffing projection for 2008/2009 represents an increase of three classroom teaching positions as compared with the 2007/2008 school year.

Subject: Update on Superintendent Search

During the May Board meeting, the Board asked for an update to be provided to the community regarding the Superintendent Search process.

After reviewing proposals and conducting interviews with several potential superintendent search firms, on May 14, 2008, the Board contracted with The Cosca Group to perform the search for the DMUSD. One important consideration in the Board's selection of The Cosca Group was that the consultants concurred with the Board's desire to do as much of the process in "open session" as possible.

On May 20, 2008, the Board met with The Cosca Group to identify strengths of the District, needs/critical issues facing the District, and the characteristics the Board would like in a new superintendent. Additionally, the Board identified various stakeholder groups that would be interviewed to provide the same input into the recruitment process. The three guiding questions for the focus interviews were:

- What do you consider to be the greatest strengths of the Del Mar Union School District?
- What do you consider to be the greatest needs/issues facing the District?
- What leadership qualities and characteristics do you wish to see in the new superintendent in order to support the strengths and deal with the needs/critical issues?

Over a two-week period at the end of May/beginning of June, The Cosca Group conducted meetings with the following stakeholders: parents, community members, principals, directors, classified staff, certificated staff and members of the PTAs, School Site Councils and the Del Mar Schools Education Foundation.

On June 11, 2008, the Board met with The Cosca Group to review all of the community input. That input was used to develop consensus on the final list of

answers regarding strengths of the District, needs/critical issues facing the District, and characteristics of a new superintendent. Based on that input, The Cosca Group developed a draft brochure that will be used in the recruitment process. On June 18, 2008, the Board met with The Cosca Group to review and finalize the content and format of the recruitment brochure.

Based on a recommendation from The Cosca Group, the Board approved a closing date of August 4, 2008 for all applications. The Cosca Group will then screen applicants and conduct necessary background checks. In order to attract the strongest pool of applicants, **The Cosca Group strongly recommended that the Board be the only participants in the review of applications.** As such, the Board will review applications during the week of August 4th.

The Board is planning to meet on August 8 with The Cosca Group to determine the candidates who will be interviewed. Ideally, we will then be able to interview candidates the following week.

Although the Board desires to have a new superintendent in place at the beginning of the 2008/2009 school year, the reality of this occurring will be determined by the availability of the final candidates.
