



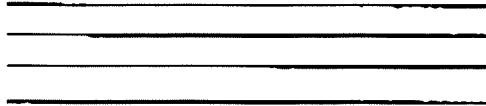

Dear Parents:

The Board of Trustees and the entire DMUSD staff are looking forward to the beginning of the 2008 – 2009 school year. In continuing our commitment to electronic communication with the community and staff, **this will be the only mailing you will receive from the District.** All of the information you need to begin the 2008 – 2009 school year, such as schedules, master calendars, special orientation events, supply lists, and special school activities will be posted on the district website at <http://www.dmusd.org>, starting August 13, 2008.

The purpose of this mailing is to share with you the information you will need to access the 2008 – 2009 electronic class lists on the district website beginning Friday, August 22nd at 5:00 p.m.

The 2008 – 2009 class lists will remain posted on the DMUSD website 24 hours a day through Monday, August 25th, the first day of school. Parents who lack Internet access at home are encouraged to visit a public library to gain Internet access at no charge.

To reach the class locator system, please visit www.dmusd.org/locator or www.delmarschools.com/locator. To locate your child's teacher, use the ID number of _____ and the date of birth of _____. Upon completing the entries, click the FIND button. Your student's information will be displayed along with the names of other student's in his/her class. To protect the privacy of other students, only the first name and first initial of the last name will be displayed.

Any parent who experiences "TECHNICAL DIFFICULTIES" in reaching the 2008 – 2009 class lists should try again at a later time over the weekend, and then if you experience repeated technical difficulty, e-mail the District webmaster at webmaster@dmusd.org. The webmaster does not have access to any student information nor will he be able to answer any questions about class lists or student placement; he is available for technical assistance only.

Thank you for your cooperation in maintaining the confidentiality of your student's ID number and date of birth. Please do not forward this information to anyone else. Please refer any questions to the school district. PLEASE NOTE: No student placement changes will be considered by site principals during the first two weeks of school.

If you wish to receive district/school e-mail messages, and the 2008 – 2009 district/school newsletters throughout the year, **please register at the District website for this service on Friday, August 22nd** after you pull up your student's class assignment (YOU WILL NEED THE NAME OF YOUR STUDENT'S TEACHER TO COMPLETE THE ELECTRONIC REGISTRATION). If you do not have access to a computer, please secure a copy of the information, schedules, and calendars referred to at any school site. There is a lot of information that you don't want to miss.

Please visit the DMUSD website frequently from August 13th until the opening of school for up-to-date information on school startup. If your student participates in the DMUSD after-school/child care programs at their school site, you will need to go to the District website, which has a link for after-school/child care. Information about the program is listed there. Please call the After-School Programs office at (858) 793-0071 if you need additional information.
